- 3. What are the two noticeable evil in this passage (see Amos 5:14). What did the man answer Jesus about anyone to help him (John 5:7-8)? The difference between God and man is willingness to help.
- 4. From the answer Jesus gave the man who was ill v 14. What do you learned about your own relationships? What is the purpose God sent Jesus (see Isa 51:9; 54:10; Zec 12:10;) Jesus was more than willing to have his body be lacerated to save you. How does what Jesus do help you change your approach?
- 5. (John 5:16-20) A Remarkably important question: What stirs up humans to be hounding Jesus because he heal a man? Why are humans acting as an accuser because Jesus made a paralyzed man whole? And gives humans an opportunity to choose to be united and do good or allow further development which will potentially harm the whole world. It implies the arrival of a turning point, and decisive change taking place; between humans on the earth! When we make choices (Gen 1:1-31-3:1-17)

(Please read your own bible notice good and evil is not at war).

- God sent Jesus to teach us good and evil signals approach of a potential crisis. And how to fix problems for the whole world at creation and in (Jn 1:1-5)
- Depiction of Good comes from God's mouth (Gen. 1-3)
- Depiction of evil comes from humans mouth (Rev. 16:13-21) because of evil spirits. Do you see that\_\_\_\_\_?
- Jesus adapts God's mannerism and models them not his own opinion, but agreeing with God and solving problems.

# INTRODUCTION



Good & Evil Relates To knowledge and Humans evil Actions (Gen. 2-3)! The first lesson about Good and Evil in specific words God decided to inform us that evil came about by (Satan's) evil communication and He points out that human's willingness to lend one's self to actually do evil will cause death to spread throughout the earth. Which harm every humans. The strategy God put forward is that to conquer evil we must do good by providing whatsoever is necessary to: Rescue Humans From The Enemy Satan And His Human Terrorist Organizations?

# ■ WE, (ALL) HUMANS SEARCH THE HOLY BIBLE TO KNOW WHY IT WAS?

The teacher John, opens up his podium linking lessons back to the book of Genesis and pointing out the reasons for human suffering. He stresses on the differentiation between good and evil works. **(Genesis 3:1-17) Evil** is introduce to us as knowledge and a general sentiment to evil and combination of specific actions.

Good and Evil' was never meant to be a lesson or example for how we get to heaven. Good and Evil in Genesis helps us to identify how unfavorable conditions forms, develops or one well on the way. The first reported disorder or situations gave humans the opportunity to learn, we must, choose to be united; do good or allow a further development of evil which potentially harms the whole world. That is totality of evil = knowledge when mixed with humans evil actions.

John put forward some cases of gross human suffering which gave the people witnessing the evil a chance to counter evil with good. He presents each case, as arrival of a turning point, and decisive change that takes place on the earth. To bring a series or sequence of action; between humans on the earth! When we make choices. It allows us to see that we humans face considerable risk and negotiations are critical. Your option is to do the right thing. 'For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing whether it be good or whether it be evil **(Ecclesiastes 12:14).** Your work is an action (good or bad) activities. And the Bible says that you will be judged for your actions. Do you understand that?

We should study the Bible. To learn about actions and the actions results. God shows the two first people a man and woman in an unfavorable condition. One which signals the approach of a crisis. He explains their actions and the actions results when humans refuse to be united and work in unity to stop evil from advancing. Potentially and intensity and conditions always change the shape of future events and life of all generations of people not yet born awfully, spreading deaths, destruction, chaos and ruin. God allows a Serpent (being) to intentionally terrorize the first woman, at creation. It went far beyond, much more than a human should be ask to bear. It encourages Eve to modify the world. But it is her actions harmed the entire world. During their analysis the Bible shows that the man, filled a niche aiming to support his counterpart spreading evil throughout the entire world.

(John 5: 7) A sick man gave voice to his struggles, telling Yeshua (Jesus) I have no one to help me." This was the old report which is found in the New Testament writing of the Bible. There are older records. What change is in your neck of the woods?

We have long understood the defining characteristic separating humans from God is knowledge of evil and evil actions. When Adam and Eve came to a turning point and had a choice to do good or evil. Eve was terrorize by the serpent. They listen to lies, harmed themselves and the whole world. The primary question for you to answer is, how can today's humans allow our self to be used by terrorists? To be terrorizing each other beyond or in an unnatural terroristic manner? Why would anyone be still quicker to band together and do evil?

Who is the King of Terrors (Job 18:11-14)? (Job chapter 1-42) introduces us to Satan the (spirit being) receiving permission to (test, torment, terrorize) Job. But was it Satan? Or was it humans that torment or terrorize Job? Who did it? People just like you and me. Fell upon Job's servants and murdered them? Job's animals stolen. Who stole his animals? Guess? How hard is it to identify the differences between Good and Evil actions? Some evils are allowed in your own life. So what do you want to know? And to do?

With all evil conditions in the world, blame, disapproval! What is the most meaningful life's lesson you learn from being horrify about a doctor's terrible prognosis of a ferocious disease ravishing a human body? What do you learn seeing your fellowman terrorize unnaturally in inhumane ways? Why would you deal with another person in a vicious manner? Pitiless? If you follow the growth of mankind in scripture to do Good or Evil is a personal choice. You have a great opportunity each day to do good or to do harm to others.

On the other hand, Jesus brings us back to Creation of the Shabbat and explains the thought of God. And shows the dignity of humans' life. That no law no matter how holy it is; ought to be applied in a way that would oppress a person (please read Mark 3:3-4)! Jesus wants to rescue you, from the terrorist and terrorist organizations. Have you considered ways to share his love with humans? Next question, after all of the historical reports of evil! Why are terrorists and terrorist organizations receiving human help today? The Bible introduce the devil as a tormentor. A serpent. Barbarous and sadistic.

# PERIODS OF TEST

John takes us back to Genesis where a series of "first" began taking shape in the earth in physical form.

- 1. <u>(Genesis 2:15-17)</u> Humans period of testing starts. Next test. Adam and Eve test with good and evil.
- 2. (Deuteronomy 8:2) "Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years to humble and test you in order to know what was in your heart." An entire nation of people Israel's test.

John presents Yeshua (Jesus) to us as the one, who gives knowledge about the entirety of the universe and how to fulfil one's destiny.

(John 5:39) reads, "You study the Scriptures diligently because you think that in them you have eternal life. These are the very scriptures that testify about me." Jesus is explaining that the same as you study any other text for learning, how to have a good life. It is the Holy Bible that provides all the knowledge we need to learn how to be like Jesus and do good works.

# WELCOME: To Your Choice Toward Stopping Evil Spiraling And Crippling Humans

Two very important questions to be answered. First, why would an angel be sent to (trouble or agitated) the water at a certain season? Second, what action was the angel trying to extract from the abled body people? Or from those who were previously held bound by sickness? According to patterns, God allows his angels to test humans action. God wants to see what you will do. Angels, demon, humans create agitating conditions in which humans gets to make decisions. What would you do if an angel is agitating the water and you receives your healing? When you are healed. Would you wait around and try to help others? Slide back for a moment what are you doing to fix the problems in your own life? Your home? Community? Nation? World? The bible tells us 'For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing whether it be good or whether it be evil (Ecclesiastes 12:14).

Your work is an action (good or bad) activities. And the Bible says that you will be judged for your actions. Do you understand that? You would think perhaps by now more people would be asking how can we stop this evil? How do we put a limit on how much distress one man should endure? Why not one person says this is the limit? How can we help him snap out of this oppression? Bondage? Who asked him do you need my help? The passage in John 5, is an image of our world today of the sicknesses that bound individuals. The types of sicknesses. Frustrations between people and the evil behaviors. So do we ask how can we help the sick in our midst?

At a critical turning point, one in which we humans make a choice between to do good or sit back and allow evil to breakout an harm ourselves began (Gen 1:1-31-3:1-17-John chapter 5 is the passage of our discussions but we are taking a look back at histories)

# A Strong Amount Of Invalids, Blind, Paralyzed Males And Females Throughout The Whole World Today

When John 5:4 says an angel was agitating the water. This suggests that the action, is disturbing humans by causing mental discomfort of varying intensity. Perhaps some people had minor disturbances, but one man was provoke for 38 years. What did the other people present do to stop that one man from being troubled? What distinct action would be useful?

#### YESHUA (JESUS) DID NOT COME TEACHING A DIFFERENT OPINION HE GAVE US THE BEST APPROACHES

Yeshua's actions are showing us how humans should live and work together; so each person fulfil purpose. The original plan of God is that each human would be put through tests. Each of us must face unfavorable conditions. You want to be healed first. Then when you see others in chaos or being tortured by Satan (Gen 3:1-27). You fix the problem under your nose. By working to stop the spread of evil whither it is a sickness of the mind or physical. You should become united, (one in spirit) with the one in pain to counter evil until sick humans are whole.

# What Was It And Why Was It - Two Ways The Tormentor Test Humans

- 1. First pattern suggests, the tormentor wants something. Wants to extract something from the person who is (tested, tortured, agitated) or the (angel) wants a specific action from the people who are witnesses witnessing the activities.. Notice, here is an opportunity to help transform the life of someone suffering!
- 2. Second pattern, Satan ravish the human body for his own gain. Play games with one's mind. Can you stop him from making someone becoming less than what God created humans to be? God has made careful thought into the gifts he gave you. Have you use them?

The book of Genesis tells us God never wanted Adam to be alone. This involves the privilege of choosing to make a second human, an individual one gifted to help (Genesis 2:19) So YHWH, God said: It is not good for the man to be alone, I will make him a helper corresponding to him. This stresses the careful thought in making the woman. Contrast this verse with the rest of creation, God had already made a large variety of things. God said everything was very good. If something is not good it is the opposite of good. Having no option, of help, when Adam was alone, God fix Adam's problem. Which denotes with a helpmate Adam become whole. When Adam receives help from God Adam said this about Eve, this one is his own partner to be helping him. How did we rebel and be not wanting to help the way God wants us to do in the earth?

The unusual style of John's writing links to the opening of Genesis! Where we find God speaking to the world and everything responding
favorable. With the revelation (Genesis 1:3) of Yeshua (Jesus) as the Light of the world giving life to everything. Both the language in Genesis and
actions of God throughout history reveals, but especially in John that God has always had to act as protector and a shield to keep us alive.
Indeed John point out the pattern God gave Adam and Eve, in Genesis is, for humans to progress the primary focuses are to have people
collectively act upon shared ideas and in love make the right decisions beneficial to the whole world. Both Genesis and John unfolds that
humans were (annoyed, agitated, irritated) by the action of Satan. In Genesis to show us the craftiness of Satan God took a step back. Watched a
serpent (tested, tormented, troubled, agitated) Eve. No one came to help her. When help came they both did evil. Fails to do right by each other.
The primary question is, do you know if an angel is agitating you? Someone you know? What behaviors does it wants to extract from you?
What are some problems why humans work hard and cannot be satisfied? Why are there so much grief? In the book of Matthew Jesus simple
adapts God's mannerism and follow the instructions. (Mat 4:24) tells us these were Jesus' action. "And his fame went throughout all Syria, and
people brought to him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and those which were possessed with devils and

those which were lunatic, and those that had the palsy, and he healed them." Jesus uses the same patterns of God to care for people. Jesus

mimics God's mannerism at Creation. When he transform what was empty into a full world. With everything very good.

1b. What was God's purposeful perception to allow the serpent to torment or test humans? In John chapter 5, the apostle begins his account by putting a name to the face of evil diseases. And behaviors associated with evil. Are you puzzled about your purposes? Do you feel held down? Puzzled about the evil outbreak of diseases?



Everyone has a specific call. The key principle is get to know God personally for one's self. Read His book. Talk to God and listen to Him. Ask yourself, then why aren't majority of people in the world living and experiencing a joyful type of life? Relationship?

Let us repeat that in John's unique style of writing he links back to (Genesis) the earliest sign of calamity attributed to the serpent (devil, evil spirit) arousing uncontrollable feelings in those two humans; producing erratic and unexplained sicknesses (mental disturbances and behaviors harmful to each other (Gen.3:1-17). Those two people brought about changes in social, economic and cultural life! After they sinned and debased each other, by quarrelling, pointing the finger at the next person without enough effort towards real solutions. What did God do to them? The Bible paints a complete picture of major confusion, division, threats and murders. As such the best course is to isolate individuals female and male and their specific behaviors. Try to determine the source of some historical problems and the ones facing us today. The primary question for all of us, one that is very necessary is: Am I a string-puppet in Satan's schemes to murder humanity? Those two first people first-born grow up and murdered his own brother because of resentful thoughts in his mind (Genesis 4:1-12).

You are not the only one who struggles with explosive jealousy (see Num. 5:14). You are not the only one being vexed—dealing with continuous lying (1 Kings 22:1-23). Do you think you are the only one who is obsessed with vengeance (Judges 9:23)?

You are not the only one experiencing demonic mental confusion (1 Sam 16:14). Not the only one who had to deal with downgraded status. Get it? Don't ever think you are the only one who can't stop worshipping idol or demons (Hos 4:12). But what can you do to stop it? Some of the above sicknesses are allowed in your own life. What can you do to fix some of the problems in the world? In your neck of the woods? Asking what line is crossed why people became diseased. You want to know the foundation of our problems. But how do we fix it? People are irritated by each other. Angry and provoke. Reflect on how you are treating the people in your own life today. Are you behaving in a terroristic manner toward anyone?

- 1. What was the impact of these sick people on the community? How many people were depressed? The Bible says there "lay a great multitude of invalids." How many were feeling hopeless? What was preventing the other people from doing something to help the paralyzed man who was there for thirty eight years? What could be God's purposeful perception to allow an angel troubling the water? Is this an abnormal pattern? What was the angel there to extract from people? God commanded humans to care for each other (Genesis 2:15)? What troubled Eve? Most importantly, what would stir humans, agitated those people in the Bible to harass the Lord Yeshua? The first statement is the people speaks against Yeshua. Second they plotted how to harm him. Why do humans join together to harm each other? The primary question is, why was there no helper to help this paralyzed man? And last but not least not one person at the pool of Bethesda became abhorrent to the tormenting of a person who is held captive? How many of us are guilty of unwilling to be helpful? How does that behavior conforms to the plan of God for humanity?

Contrast these stories to beliefs in the world today. What conditions do you witness? Is there someone perishing and terrorized in your midst? Is your neighbor being troubled by a spiritual condition? Physical or other? What are the changes you have implement?
  - In John chapter 5, an angel had responsibility to agitate the water. Two primary questions. Of all the humans present, and looking on at an action that is disturbing one man's mind causing mental discomfort to varying intensity not cared enough to help him? No one recognized that the man was oppressed? Not one of those who were previously agitated and suffered but later was healed remembered what it feels like to be held down? DO YOU FORGET YOUR TURNING POINT? Do you forget that God sent someone to help you get over your hump?
  - The other questions are. Do you not know how to be a cooperator with the word of God? And help others as if you did it for God?
  - These are all our problems in the world today. Where people, choose to not remember being helpless. When you triumph do you refuse to turn and help someone else at some point in your life to be healed? You can't remember what it feels like waiting for assistance to be finally set free from your miseries? Do you no longer have a mental image of longing for a new life? Did you not yearn for or desires a new journey in your own life?
- Notice that the paralyzed man was held down by a disease.

Thirty-eight years it took with many turning point presents itself. So ask yourself, why was Jesus' approach to scriptures exactly according to the way it is written (John5:36)? And the purposes! Why would Jesus adapt God's mannerism?

He disregard the methodology and practice of man and kept to the understanding and

truth of scriptures. Why? Why do good?
Who benefited from Jesus' action? Meanwhile, man acknowledge and accepts handed down traditions above the Holy Bible.

We need to pause, let us question our own motive before you take action.

#### **PATTERNS**

How many persons have you sit back and watched them be dissected and destroy? While it was in your power to genuinely help. I am not speaking of helping yourself by exploiting them while you enrich yourself.

# THESE ARE THE SUCCESSIVE STEPS OF TERRORIZING A HUMAN FAR BEYOND WHAT HE SHOULD BE ASKED TO BEAR

# YOU DID IT

Why is it so difficult to do good? Good and Evil in Genesis came about not as the way to get into heaven. But rather, it identifies unfavorable conditions that develops or is well on the way. And gives humans an opportunity to choose to be united and do good or allow further development which will potentially harm the whole world. The primary question is, why do people need to be tormented to extract from us what should be natural to do and advance in our lives? This is the Bible's explanation of one way of tormenting a person.

#### SOME WAYS A TORMENTOR IS ALLOWED TO TORMENT HUMANS

- (Matthew 18:34) the Bible describes a man who was handed over to the tormentor until he paid in full all the debts he owe. The practice here is not describing a disease eating away one's flesh. But rather financially, the debt collector pick apart the victim's life and search for any remaining assets until the person is totally destroyed.
- In what ways is the action of the debt collector picking away at a person until he or she is ruined different from the physical destruction of a life? Do we know when enough is enough? What is making it unclear so that the feature of helping cannot be distinguished? What is keeping people confused? Is it distraction and personal thoughts that blurs our understanding for God's will and his normal order for our life? Do you know when you are refusing to accept God's authority?
- Practical solution: God says He does not give any of us more than we can bear. (1 Cor. 10:11-13) These things happened to them as an example, and they were written as a warning, for us, as the last times come upon us...No temptation has seized you beyond what people normally experience, and God can be trusted not to allow you to be tempted beyond what you can bear." So why are people breaking down; committing suicide? This does not only mean that God is watching to see what we do to help those needing help. But God is taking note in what ways we humans are contributing and prolonging the suffering of your counterparts.

# A Certain Man Was Diseased For Thirty Eight Years Every Time He Try To Get Into The Pool He Failed

- a). Number 38 is connected to destruction because of sins and man's repeated attempt to kill each other (see Ezekiel 38)
- b). A descendant of Israel's lack of faith, spying out land God told them to possess sets them back 38 years (Num 32:18-13).
- c) Think long and hard. Israel travel in miseries 38 years they know what it feels like to suffer! right (Due 2:14)?
- d) it is easy for us to ask how could they watch someone suffering for 38 years and do nothing. Isn't it? Impossibility of opposing or rejecting evil, can be involve in their life, because they have become inferior due to their thinking and behaviors. This will also be the case for us as well. Usually, when mankind adjoins one's self with evil lust demons—fear the gods and live by man's customs and do secret things that are not right according to the laws of God. These actions provokes God.

Adonai typically will warn us to turn from our evil ways when we refuse to listen we will become worthless (2 Kings 17:15).

# THE FORMAT AND THE PATTERNS OF DESTRUCTIONS IN THE LIFE OF HUMANS

The bible introduced Adam and Eve to the world as the first two humans. (Gen 2;18), reads, "and the Lord God said, it is not good that the man should be alone: I will make him an help meet for him. (Gen 2:23) and Adam said, this is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh; she will be called woman..." (Gen 3:1-5) now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God made. And he said unto the woman, yea hath God said ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? And the woman said unto the serpent, we may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. And the serpent said unto to the woman, ye shall not surely die, for God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods...(read Gen 3:1-17).

I read it. First pattern is, a spiritual being torments one's mind in an unnatural way, and if the persons are weak they succumbed to the demon and do harm to themselves and the whole world. The two first persons, failed because of: evil communication, lies, and a "helpless partnership" and unwillingness to do good. But agreeable in doing evil. Their action brings death into the world.

What impresses you about this statement? Keep reading (1 Cor 5:5) reads, "I have decided to deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of his flesh that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. [these are the words of Paul]. How do you see yourself in these accounts? Do you believe any of your actions shows compatibility with anyone to do wickedness? Can you believe it? For thirty-eight years there was no one to help a man having difficulty to get his healing? Why does it take Jesus to have pity on him? Do we not see when a person is being tormented and ask to bear too much? Who in your own family needs your help?

(In the book of Nehemiah chapter two, Nehemiah left his job working for a king to go, repair a Sheep's gate. This is an impressive personal bearing of one's responsibility towards the things of God? Yes? The work that Nehemiah did he came up under severe oppositions. Mocking and people trying to block him from completing the job. Were the people mocking them, exhibiting resentment because of a show of superiority? Was pure evil in their heart toward the things of God? Despite the opposition, Nehemiah, rose up with other leaders and they rebuilt the Gate. And set it apart as holy. Why were they not afraid of the people threatening them?

Nehemiah did stay on and address the people suffering needs. But in general, take notice much emphasis is place on the things that are used for worshipping God, but that is not the same approach toward keeping people safe and wanting to stop them from perishing. God command Moses to apply to consecrated things and humans equal care (Exod. 38-40).

# STUDY TO KNOW WHAT IT IS. AND WHY IT IS.

# The Picture Of Thirty-eight Years.

(John 5:5-9) One man was there who had been ill for thirty-eight years. Yeshua seeing this man and knowing that he had been there a long time, said to him, "Do you want to be healed?" The sick man answered "I have no one to put me in the pool when the water is disturbed and while I'm trying to get there, someone goes in ahead of me." Yeshua said to him, "Get up, pick up your mat and walk!"

First, let us look at the pattern of 38 years. Remember that the Israelites where held in the wilderness for 38 years being agitated (Numbers 32:18-13; Due 2:1-14). It is important to say that God knows this is not a thing worthy to be imitated or worthy of imitation. Why did Jesus need to follow the people of Israel in the wilderness to keep them safe from human beings like themselves (Exodus 17:5, Numbers 21)? Stubborn people is why God had to care about the people of Israel and rescued them. What was God's solutions (read Psalm 78). It is a lesson to us of what could or should be done.

### God rescued and release them to help them become the change they want to see in the world.

One thing is the Israelites should not forget how painful the experiences had been for them. It had been 38 years of sufferings, death and destructions for them and their children. For most people we forget that God or someone had to rescue us from injustices. When the people of Israel were suffering they lost many loved ones to death. So many of them refuse to display self-control of simple things as their lustful desires for specific food. They preferred to be killed than do what God requires of them. (Just read Psalm 78).

In the Bible God often uses the word remember—indicating an event and the action taken to stop or prevent disasters from crippling the life of humans. Remembering is to bring not just the event to one's mind but we must process the physical outcome of the past events and then take action to stop it from happening again. In any event history keeps repeating itself and definitely not always in a good way. People who have the power to improve life for many lacks courage. Refusing to courageously stand up for goodness.

What is it that held the man for thirty-eight years? Why it took Jesus to come and have compassion on a man along with his own people? How long did the angel agitated the situation? What did the angel want to extract from the crowd?

Perhaps the angel wanted to ravish the humans bodies for his own gains.

Most important and the lesson to learn is that no one was willing to stop the success of distressing a man.

Evil spirits or our own thoughts leads us to do harm.

Irrespective whether if you are meek or mild mannered evil thoughts comes to our minds that is aimed at having us committing

murder. Or having us help them to do evil. Thousands of people are ravished by diseases and die.

#### WHAT IT IS AND WHY IT IS?

Keep reading, the Bible anchors the development stage as God created male and female, created he them. "In his own image, after our likeness" (Gen1:26). God merges this event into an elaboration that the woman Eve did ate fruit and she gave to Adam and he ate. Why? Did Eve believe a false claim that serves as a distinction or superiority of the gods? Then what happened? They tried to mask their unworthy nature and promote a notion that they are able to fix the problem without help from God. Within the passage God tells us He had to kick them out of the Garden. To stop them eating the tree of life and live forever, in a miserable state (Genesis)

- Satan's mystery plan, is to make humans invisible or vanish in a split second. He sets out to prove to mankind all actions both of the wise and foolish ends in death. To prove humans are nothing. Do you still believe Satan can't make humans invisible? When a person is murdered what happens? Fired from a job they are good at, loved, for no good reasons? Thrown out of one's home? Afflicted with pain? Sickness? Heartbroken? Robbed? Do not get mad at me, but in what ways are you helping to establish Satan's plan? Do you treat others as nothingness? Make their life feels meaningless? Why restrain a friend, workmate or family who wants to receive help? Whoever does good is of God (3John 1:11).
- In the human communities are there any "real helping" counterparts? Any place in the whole wide world? Do you understand what appeals to one's taste or desires causing us to be so cruel? What explanations do we have for providing the behaviors to trap other humans and harm them? Why do we bring a person down to a lower level and then crush him or her without a second thought?

# THE SCRIPTURES DESCRIBE GOD AS LOVE (1 JOHN 4:8)

Everything God does is coming from a place of love. The Bible explains love covers a multitude of sins. God has protected and shielded humans beyond the extent we deserve. But when Satan let loose his mystery plan, it was a covert plan to have male and female become murderers. The plan was for human's life to be like nothing. In split seconds a life is gone through evil designs carried out by unthinking humans. Blame human behavior, of harming each other on facts that our frontal lobe is not performing, how God planned. Humans' minds are jacked up. It takes great deliberate effort to love another individual. And helping has to be done on purpose as your voluntary contribution. Life's purpose is to fear and obey God because without him we can achieve nothing.

3. What are the two noticeable evil in this passage (see Amos 5:14-15). What did the man answer Jesus about anyone to help him (John 5:7)? The difference between God and man is God's willingness to help.

(Amos 5:14-15) Seek good and not evil, so that you will survive. Then Adonai ELOHEI-Tzva'ot will be with you, as you say he is. Hate evil, love good, and uphold justice at the gate. Maybe Adonai ELOHEI-Tzav'ot will take pity on the survivors of Yosef.



<u>REFLECTION:</u> In all public squares and private Jesus agreed with God. Jesus hate evil and love good, uphold justice. Had pity on humans. What do you learn as to what the serpent trying to extract from you? Is it for his gain? If so, how can you use the opportunity to save a life?

1. (John 5:7) The sick man answered, "I have no one to put me in the pool when the water is disturbed and while I'm trying to get there, someone goes ahead of me."

FIRST: A paralyzed man is trying to get to the pool without any help dear friends? (What mark does this have on you?)

SECOND: Visualize yourself in a crippling position and someone steps ahead every day receives help but leaves you helpless and

devastated. (Does this impressed the danger on us? What is the mental effect on you? Does this strike you as evil?)

THIRD: Now imagine your counter-part PARALYZED "held" mind and body bound in the most devastating situation agitated by an

angel; experiencing the most overwhelming conditions in life! Pause and think! You happily steps ahead of him? What is it? Why do we do it?

# Our challenges, our problems

The parallelism part is let me remind you "someone goes ahead." Does that sound familiar to our actions today? Might as well someone did tie down the person suffering with one's own two hands. These patterns we keep repeating over and over in each of our lives today. Stop and ask the primary question. Each one of us needs to ask our self, am I happy something hold-down others for us, inside our circles? When someone in our midst who we fear their gift is held down does that comfort us? Do you think it is okay because that way I can finally get ahead? Let us use the book of Job and look at some examples, first, people were influenced by Satan to overwhelm Job's life. When God rescued and restores Job. God rebuked Job's friends. Why? The Bible says, "After Yahweh had spoken to Job, he turned to Eliphaz the Temanite, "I am angry with you and your two friends because you have not spoken of me rightly, as has my servant Job" (Job 42). Power to please God is in all of us. Why do so many people please demons? Satan is not an archenemy of God. He is a Tormentor of the human race. It is humans who played the role of an accuser and obstructed Job. The behavior is sinful and basically an offense to God. Job tells us that sinning can do God no harm. But our action hurt people (Job 35:6).

Jesus was not manipulated. Why? Wherever Jesus went preaching, he would heal the people (Matt 9:14). He feeds them. And restore their joy.

First, notice that he repairs the human body to good health. head of pointing out the character mistakes, sin or sinfulness in one's life (John 5:14).  In particularly, this case with the paralyzed man serves to identify the form of human behavior. What is the difference with human and Jesus' approach? First pattern is, Jesus stops the wickedness afflicting him. Second pattern is, not untl he was already well then Jesus warns him about what could happen in the future, if he keeps sinning. "Worse thing will come unto thee." (John 5:14) What does this mean? Worse thing? When mankind do wicked things in the earth. What happens?  Let us reflect, Jesus displays emotion or a form of behavior; empathy a profound feeling, capable of producing action which helps the person suffering improve mentally or physical. Jesus did not offer ANY speculation, or place focuses on the reason for one's suffering. A behavior frequently noticed between male and female where we focus on needy people's character and it is used to judge or debased the individual needing help. We sometimes even restrain others who would respond by helping each other.  What did Jesus mean when he said worse thing will come unto thee? The Bible provides the explanation in (Matthew 12:43-45) When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest and findeth none. Then he saith I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept and garnished. Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself and they enter in and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse that the first. Even
ב	so shall it be also unto this wicked generation. These describes a process of spirits (spirit beings) coming to completely ruin a person. And it suggests force to demolish the body of the person. Also, consider that the spirits will prevent other humans from giving any real help. Do you understand that you need the Holy Spirit's help to guide you (See John 16:12-15)? Do you need help? Ask Jesus to send the right person who will truly help and not harm you more. Nor will they want to profit off your situation. Do you get it?

5. (John 5:16-20) Remarkably important question: Humans try to obstruct Jesus' ministry. What stirs up humans to be hounding Jesus because he heal a man? Why are humans acting as an accuser because Jesus made a paralyzed man whole? The Bible describes a situation where people hunted him to be murdered. What drives murderers to leave a person lifeless? What mess up one's will overwhelm them to do such levels of evil?

What sense does it make to be seeking Jesus for the sole purpose of condemning him to death?

(John 5:15-20) The man went off and told the Judeans it was Yeshua who had healed him; and on account of this, the Judeans began harassing Yeshua because he did these things on Shabbat. But he answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I too am working. This answer made the Judeans all the more intent on killing him---not only was he breaking Shabbat; but also, by saying that God was his own Father, he was claiming equality with God. Therefore, Yeshua said this to them: Yes, indeed! I tell you that the Son cannot do anything on his own, but only what he sees the Father doing; whatever the Father does, the Son does too. A critically important question for all of us. What must you do before others want to kill you?

#### What was Jesus doing to cause humans to want him murdered? I am also speaking about today's human desire to commit murder.

- 1. What messed up the will of humans and overwhelmed a person to take such cruel action? What is it? What is really wrong with our mind?
- 2. Do you believe murderers experience a loss of one's executable will?
- 3. What is driving an individual up to the point where he or she actually commits the action? To murder innocent humans?
- 4. This account describes how crowds of people pursue or hunt for the life of an innocent human being to deliver them blows and leave a lifeless body laying on the ground. What makes a person depart from logic and be completely unreasonable? Acting as madmen?
- 5. What is making us by our deed or word and action be harmful to another human? To be calculated and malicious to abuse a person?

# THE PUZZLING QUESTIONS

What grabs hold of an individual and drive the person to locations or even hideouts they would not normally go. But they will willingly go just to do an evil action. This has to be an insatiable appetite to commit wrongs. Evil. Very evil. To search out a human being as a target. Identify and pursue someone innocent and murder them. These are behaviors the Bible teaches to us and has shown that they are improper. Sometimes resulting from ignorance or oversight and even overindulgence in alcohol (Genesis 9:21) when Noah became drunk and behaved inappropriately. (Genesis 3: 6) Eve ate the fruit and then cause physical and mental injury to herself and the man Adam. Why are people still willing to blend into a group that lack uniformity or character just to commit murder? If we continues to believe that what we say does not matter. What we do does not matter. That what happens to men and women across the world does not matter. That what leaders do to incite looting and murder does not matter. As long as the behavior is acceptable. We are headed into a very dark area. One that no human being will be able to withstand. We all needs Godly wisdom and help to consciously understand and do what one's rational mind do not understand. Or wants to do. Think about what Paul observes over and over in his own life. He does not do the good he wants to do but rather keeps doing the evil what he does not want to do. It is sad so many people cannot bring ourselves to a place where we are disgusted with wickedness. When will we cease these manner of acting since they are evil? Arise, be the change you want to see in the world.



- a). We need the Holy Spirit's help because human's mind/heart is full of madness while we live (Eccl. 9:3b) We need divine help to cease from the evil mankind do daily.
- b). When the spirit of God is speaking through us. We look for solutions. Humble one's self. And we do not create chaos.



□ (John 5:19 & 21) "Yes indeed I tell you that the Son cannot do anything on his own, but only what he sees the Father doing: Whatever the Father does, the Son does too." 21 Just as the Father raises the dead and makes them alive so too the Son makes alive anyone he wants. CJB

Do you know why Jesus address the "action" why would he only do what he sees his Father do\_\_\_\_\_\_? Think, there were scores of sick people at the pool. Was the paralyzed man distracted\_\_\_\_\_\_\_? Why should Jesus be concern that he enjoys health\_\_\_\_\_?

Notice, Jesus did not focus on whether or not a paralyzed man was inattentive, careless. Maybe he was daydreaming! Jesus did not look for excuses not to heal him. No, not at all, Jesus sees that this man was held down and need human help to continue his journey. Waiting for thirty-eight years without receiving help. No, not even one of the people witnessing his pain helped.

Jesus did. He provided the man with what he needed. Jesus chose to give new life to the paralyzed man, who had an inactive life. He helped him to become alert. Restores what he has lost to the enemy and gives the man an opportunity to get on his journey to a new life. Adding, he provided him counseling and understanding how to maintain his healing. Be watchful of evil spirits that wants to live in your body.

Just the same way God did at Creation. When he created a pleasurable world and handed it over to humans who had done nothing to be awarded it.

## WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO HAVE FAITH?

Faith is the process of doing something in order to deal with a problem or difficult situation facing humanity. Faith is your work. Your action. Fight for your faith to believe the Word of God to think like Jesus does. And adapts his mannerism to go and help people fix the problems in their lives. First you need the Holy Spirit's help to be delivered from your own dark and evil thoughts. When you are delivered from the dark and evil thoughts remember God's help and be the change you want to see in the world. The thoughts God has for us is good. He provided us with good advices to be able to reach our God-given destinies.

- Yeshua's actions takes mental effort. He takes the time to think about you. He values you. The image of Yeshua (Jesus) going to where a paralyzed man is held down and tormented was a measured action. He went out of His way to deal with a particular problem. He went to give that man new life. The understanding is the will of God remains to help right the wrongs done to humans. Specifically the ones you are dealing with.
- The identity of Yeshua's action are the ones he is training us to do. To begin to use God's plan the right way and make it work for healing the injured or brokenhearted ones.

A person in your midst maybe exposed to harm or loss. You are gifted to help someone improves their health. To help a person experience peace in their life. It is our responsibility to do good. Jesus was in a dark world and he chose to emit light that others may see, come alive and honor God (Go and read 2. Corinthian 9:12), your generosity will cause people to thank God. Imagine someone is sick for thirty-eight years living a life of hopelessness. And one day you happen to be the light God sent to shine hope and hold the person's hand bringing him or her out of darkness to come and do great things for himself and the world. Think about it, you are that vessel. God wants to use and do something good. Your options are I place before you life and death, blessing and curse choose life so that you and your children will live (Deut. 30:19). What does that mean?

Allow the word of God to fill your mind with awareness. Teach you how to identify hurting people and the appropriate help to give. Also in your own life, choose the kind of signals you want to put out there on your platform for others to see. Your words bring life. It can also brings death. But never hesitate to rebuke evil intent and actions. First understand, we are all vulnerable. Arriving at a good place in your life, try to attract people likeminded around you. People who are opposite of what the scriptures command us to do NEEDS you. Do not accept their behavior as the norms. Rebuke them privately. Or openly if needed.

One question he left with us is. When I return will I find faith on the Earth (Luke 18:8).

In spite of what you are seeing with your eyes in the nations. No healing of your bruises. The chaos in your own life, around the world; continue to trust Messiah, Yeshua. Stand up for the truth God's word teaches. Reject lies. Stop harming humans. Everything happening in the world today occurred in the Bible. Stop trying to manipulate people to harm others. People harming themselves, teach them God's word, let the Holy Spirit help them change. The end is here. You, choose to do good, because God is coming to judge your actions....as recorded in the books (Revelations 20:12).
