ABSTRACT

(Prov. 8:22) "The LORD brought me forth as the first of his works, before his deeds of old; I was formed long ages ago; at the very beginning, when the world came to be." See (Gen. 1:1-5; I John 1:1-2; Rev 19:13).

The most intriguing parts of the book of John's records, mirrors beginning of creation. Where God came giving divine instructions to the world. And Yeshua known as the Light; arise, chaos stops! Instantly, everything began to arise, sprung speedily and fruitful promptly. His life tells us how to deal with chaos. The word "arise," literally means, "stand up!" You, stand up! Lift up your "voice" against the enemy, lets overthrow him; with your fury for the souls of your people.

HE IS ABLE TO COMBACT CHAOS

Seeing our lives mirrored in the chaos of creation is a very sobering experience. On the other hand, it can be inspiring. According to the author of the book of John, the real beginning of things is beyond time as we know it to be. Outside of time, space, something that is not easily explained, a true mystery. When Yeshua came to us as the image of God (Col. 1:15).

God first entered the world with a history of the; "Word's" full power! His knowledge, where he ordains signs in the heaven, foretells the future, and reveals certain mysteries. Genesis went on to show the Sun in the skies arise shine, came to the "Source" God Himself, proclaiming his marvelous works. The moon marks months, rules the Feast Days, special celebration days for you of His superb works. The stars beautify the skies. No escaping the rainbow! Laying superbly for all to see. Everything has its purpose. Much more important, Yeshua reveals he is the means by which God is communicated to humans.

WHATEVER HAS COME TO BE

At this point of Creation, the one who fulfills all the strategy of God "Yeshua" is introduced to the world as the "Light!" Entered at creation, and the world reached the greatest moment of renewal, justice, grace, love, mercy. God's divine love and the protection which all of creation needed. We are yearning for right now. It was the ultimate rescue mission of a world that crashed was in complete total chaos. God had introduced the world as: "In the beginning, when God began to create the heavens and the earth had no form and was void; darkness was over the deep and the Spirit of God hovered over the waters" (Gen. 1:1-2). Imagine that? The earth was void. Darkness hovered over it (Genesis 1:3-5). "All things were made through him, and without him nothing came to be. Whatever has come to be, found life in him, life which for human beings, was also light, light that darkness could not overcome." We need Jesus!

Ponder about it. Embodied in a perfect man sent from God as a human—he voluntarily paid the price for the sins of every person. Who else; but God could look at slaves, those worshipping demons, bowing down to idols—calling demons gods, making God jealous, bringing the name of God to naught, breaking His shabbat (a set apart holy day)? A people who have no respect for father or mother, murderers, adulterers, thieves, liars, bearing false witnesses against our neighbors, coveting other people's belongings.

Yet, God would look for an occasion to bring Himself to us. To save our souls from destruction. What love is this? Who but God could do this? Not one of us. (John 1:11-14) He came to his own, yet his own people did not receive him; but to all who received him, he empowers to become children of God, for they believe in his name. These are born, but not by seed, or carnal desire, not by the will of man: they are born of God. And the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us.; and we have seen his glory, the glory of the only Son of the Father: fulness of truth and loving-kindness." John says God gives Himself to us. What an incredible love between us!

THE HUMILITY OF YESHUA

According to the author John, when asked "who are you?" He said "I am the voice of the one crying out in the wilderness: Make straight the way of the Lord!" (see Isaiah 40:3). This happened in Bethabar beyond the Jordan, where John was baptizing. Next day, John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "There is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" It is he of whom I said: A man comes after me, who is already ahead of me, for he was before me. I myself did not know him, but I came baptizing to prepare for him, so that he might be revealed in Israel. He also gave this testimony, "I saw the Spirit coming down on him, like a dove from heaven, and resting on him. I myself did not know him, but God, who sent me to baptize, told me. You will see the Spirit coming down, and resting on the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit/ Yes, I have seen! And I declare that this is the Chosen One of God!"

The word "Lamb" in the dictionary relates to someone "gentle" and "loveable," especially a child. Think about it, the one with Supremacy, more powerful than anyone else adapts to any situation and makes the best of it, as a child do.

These are the visible experiences recorded by the author John for us to learn what to do. From John's point of view, he is putting a human character, to the supernatural power, dominion, the legal rights to rule people, things; which is attach to Jesus. The Old Testament introduces Jesus but for many readers it has not fully captured His power and show what it is, who owns it, what it cost to come to us. His glorious power is far above words. The word was made flesh and dwelt among us (John 1:14). A mystery, that the King, Sovereign of sovereigns, Almighty God, choose to come to us as a little child, name Yeshua, to grow up among humans in plain sight. By the time he got to adulthood, the glory, all the power of God began revealing to the whole world. John brings the readers, the Messiah's miracles, teachings, authority over the adversarial power of Satan; afflicting human's body with malady, blindness, paralysis, death.

EMPHASIS IS ON THE MIRACLES

- Turning water into wine (John 2)
- Healing of a sick son (John 4:47)
- ► Healing a paralytic (John 5:3)
- Feeding 5000 hungry people (John 6:2)
- Walking on the sea (John 6:20)
- ▶ Healing the man born blind (John 9:2-3)
- Raising Lazarus from the dead (John 11)

(John 1:35-40) Yeshua meets his first disciple. "On the following day, John was standing there again, with two disciples. And Jesus walked by, John looked at him and said, "There is the Lamb of God." On hearing this, the two disciples followed Jesus. He turned and saw them following, and he said to them, "What are you looking for?" They answered Rabbi (which means Master), where are you staying? Jesus said, "Come and see." So they went and saw where he stayed, and spent the rest of the day with him. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon. Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, was one of the two who heard what John had said and followed Jesus. Why is Jesus choosing disciples? Why did he tell them follow me?

Do not believe Jesus life was easy. His action tells us how to deal with the "last days" crisis. John painstakingly tells the crisis and the actions that works. Years after seeing the miraculous; power of God at work through Jesus; it causes jealousy to arise. This miracle working 100% man

from a humble beginning brought renewal of life, help out at a wedding, feeding the hungry, went all over and at that point envious religious leaders ask for Rome's help to get rid of Jesus. In the meantime, Jesus is going about doing good, but something is stirring the people to desire chaos, darkness and trouble. What is it? Who?

FOLLOW ME

What does this teach you about the character of God? What is the combination of his qualities that makes him this particular kind of human? Let us ask our self—how does my character relate to the people around me? In what ways am I serving them? What is in me that makes me different from an evil person? There is a mystery about the son of God. How can he be God, and empty out himself to become as ordinary as we are? Look long and hard at that.

(John 1:43-46) The next day, Jesus decided to set off for Galilee. He found Philip and said to Him, "Follow me." Philip was from Bethsada, the town of Andrew and Peter. Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the law, and the prophet: he is Jesus, son of Joseph, from Nazareth." Nathanael replied, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" Philip said to him, "Come and see." When Jesus saw Nathanael coming, he said to him, "Here comes an Israelite, a true one; there is nothing false in him."

It made good sense to follow Jesus. He has the highest authority in Heaven and on the earth period (reference Matt 28: 18-20).

3 DAYS LATER FIRST CHAOS OCCURRED

Look at humans' past and learn that feasting and celebrations are ordained by God. He loves to see His dear children happy and enjoying our celebrations. It is His joy to watch us drinking the wine from our vineyards and exchanging the gifts he blesses us with. To put food in your mouth, eat, swallow it and be satisfied. These things when done in an orderly way makes God happier. The only one envious and mad at us is Satan, that old devil. Eat your heart out old devil.



Miracle 1). Turning water into wine

(John 2: 1-5) Three days later there was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus was also invited to the wedding with his disciples. When all the wine provided for the celebration had been served, and they run out of wine, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine," Jesus replied, "Woman, what concern is that to you and me? "My hour has not yet come."

Why was the mother of Jesus concerned about a wedding feast that had nothing to do with any of her children getting married? First thing first, let us pin point her faith, in Jesus. You have never seen him work miracles but you believe your son can fix the people's problem. Where is the faith in our own children? Why do many parents speak so very demoralizing and ugly to our children? Does my action match up?

(John 2: 5-7) However, his mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." Nearby were six stone water jars, set there for ritual washing as practiced by the Jews; each jar could hold twenty to forty gallons Jesus said to the servant fill the jars with water. And they filled them to the brim.

Earlier, Jesus reply to his mother, because he sees she had enough faith and trusted in the glory of God to help the people though He said, "it is not yet my time." He answered the plea, and reveal the unmatched power of God. Her request was genuine. He sees love in her heart for people. At some unique time; between the people's action—of doing what Jesus ordered to deal with the problem or difficult situation. He miraculously changed water into the highest; best quality of wine, to stop the dysfunction.

The Real Power To Us A Two-Letter Word "Do"

"Do whatever he tells you." According to Longman Dictionary, the word (do) is: 1. action, activity: example, do your homework before you watch TV. The important meaning is you spent the time to "do" something and the work is now finished. Thinking alone is not enough, do something to save others. Stretch out your hand.

(John 2:10) reads: Then Jesus said, "Now draw some out and take it to the steward." So they did. The steward tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing from where it had come; for only the servants who had drawn the water knew. Immediately he called the bridegroom, and said, "Everyone serves the best wine first, and when the people have drunk enough, he serves that which is ordinary. But you have kept the best wine until the end."

Do What He Says Or Nothing Will Change

Jesus' goal is restoration. Wine is not a basic necessity such as food. Why care? The things he is asking us to do are for our own good. What benefit does he get? Except for restoring our joy. If someone ask you what have you done to something, you have changed it in some way. Notice, the miracle did not take place until there was an action by people that show proof of changes. Once people do what Jesus said, they were able to continue enjoying themselves. Change came and improvement because of human's willingness to obey the instructions.

Very simple, the bible has provided us with several dos and don'ts; things that we should or should not do in any given situation. In His wisdom, God pointed us to the things to do and walk safely in one's life. What is happening in your home? Community? Nation? World? Are you concerned enough? Jesus' mother chose to do something about people's lack; and change their situation. You need to take action, so we achieve our goal. To give an example, many current organizations functioning properly because of volunteers who willingly do the work. What gifts do you possess that you can use to change someone's situation from bad to good?

Private or public demonstration of help

The mother was very involved, Jesus and his mother joined to fix a private issue, but the entire gathering benefitted from their actions. Two observations 1). He uses local things, materials that were available to fulfill purpose. He did not add undue stress on those already stressing out themselves. Under natural circumstances, speak to someone who owns a winery or read up on their activities. You will quickly learn it takes a long delicate process, planting, harvest, crush, pressing, and storing under the right climate. 2). Jesus being God is not limited as humans are. He just speaks and the very power that created creation is activated. (See Genesis 1:1-27).



Miracle 2). Healing a sick son

Healing of the official's son. The following words intensify real and strong faith. Jesus had gone back to Cana of Galilee. Where he did the first miracle change water into wine. An official whose son was ill heard that Jesus had come back. He went to Jesus where the Bible says, (John 4:47) he went and ask him to come and heal his son, for he was at the point of death. Jesus, said, "unless you see signs and wonders, you will not believe!" The official said, "Sir come down before the child dies." And Jesus replied, "Go, your son lives!"

People are looking for answer as to why things happened. This official place his faith in the "word," Jesus spoke and he went his way. Why this high official thinks only Jesus can help? This man heard Jesus had come back to the region. Perhaps he was enquiring about him. Think about it? This government official actively seeking for Jesus. What does this say about our character? Does it match up? He finds Jesus,

went straight and ask for a solution to his problem. Of course, Jesus rebuke him. (John 4:48) unless you see signs and wonder, you will not believe." Why not take offense? No offense taken. Why not? The official kept his focus and humbly submitted his faith, trusting that the spoken word of God is enough. That is, it. That was what created creation. That is what holds up the world (Hebrews 1:3). This man knew nothing else, would work but the word out of Jesus' mouth. It is the glory of God to help people especially those who feels trap. His trust; was not in vain. Jesus rewarded him for his faith in the healing power of the word of God.

Why do you think this father took the time to see about his son? If you are a parent, Father, mother, foster parent, caregiver, how does your action match up? Does it? Think of the position of this man? A very high place in government, power, importance and influence, but the minute Jesus said go. He went. He took his time to arrive home. When he gets home, he inquired form those there of the exact time the healing occurred. Jesus is not limited to your location. Before Him all other power bow down. You should bow your heart where you are. Kneel down and pray for your son's healing. Believe in the word of God because it works.



Miracle 3). Healing a paralytic

(John 5:5) There was a man who had been sick for thirty-eight years. Jesus saw him, and because he knew how long this man had been lying there, he said to him, "Do you want to be healed?" Imagine living in your neighborhood and someone is coming to your temple and for "38 years" they are paralyzed and not once, you ever ask, what can I do for you? What is it?

We cannot think on the one hand that we represent God and not care for people who are trapped. Is this not a combination of selfishness, rebelliousness, and insecurity? Jesus search for chaos and fix it! Jesus went to a feast in Jerusalem. Why did He go to the pool? When man refuse to help you get out of your situation God will come and help you himself. Note the sick man's response to Jesus when asked, why has he not healed in a place where people go for healing. Right there many people's hope is dashed because they don't fit in.

(John 5:6b-8) "Do you want to be healed?" And the sick man answered, "Sir, I have no one to put me into the pool when the water is disturbed; so while I am still on my way, another steps down before me." Jesus then said to him. "Stand up, take your mat and walk! And at once the man was healed and he took up his mat and walked." Notice that the man said, "I had no one." Where were all the so-call believers? Many hoping that people who claim to know God will help them but find their hopes dashed.

Compassionate Heart is what's missing

What stirs the people to attack Yeshua? Imagined no one was excited that this helpless man was given a second chance. Transformed to go and fulfil his purpose. These activities are calling each of us to do some deep reflections in our own lives. Look around you, sometime it's your own flesh and blood suffering and for "38 long years," you do nothing. Just closed our hearts to compassion, harden and bitterer.

Let us recall Job's suffering—why are so many humans unaware of the harmfulness of their action? To see someone suffering and have no concern for their wellbeing. Open your eyes, to the people around you. You have no idea about their suffering. No one saw this man that he was restricted, could barely move for thirty-eight years. No one wanted to lift a finger to do him some good. Notice that Jesus first concern was not with the man's behavior or sinful actions. He stops what was opposing him.

How do we avoid the traps of rebellion?

People across the globe are trapped. When Jesus saw that a man was bound to one spot. For thirty-eight years. He knew it ends today nothing binding him again. Once Jesus spotted him, he reached out and ask, "do you want to be healed?" Jesus instructed, stand up, and the work was finished. Then, he addresses sin (v14).

Let us step back into the past. Before sinned entered the world. There was no sickness, lack, death, none of it existed. If only the first two people had obeyed God's desire, the promise of abundant blessings upon humanity would have been fulfilled. Yet, we cannot focus on their failures. Or continue making the same mistakes. (Judges 18:6) shares, another problem; humans have the tendency to do which is right in his own eyes. Throughout the centuries the same false confidence has plagued us. Inspired by Satan, magicians, sorcery which makes people feel secure falsely. On the other hand, the level of God's humility, self-control, ability to restrain his anger in order to not destroy humans because of our bad behaviors. Is outside of the realm of our understandings.

We must thank God; praise him for his patience, unconditional love. And personal choice giving us a unique mission to represent him, speak as him, and live as him among each other. Jeremiah had this to say, "Great and Mighty Yahweh God of Host is your name! You are great in planning and mighty in deeds Your eyes follow the ways of all the humans and you give to each one according to his conduct and the fruit of their actions (Jeremiah 32:19)

Isn't this crooked thinking

What is the problem, why many so-call believers do not want to follow Jesus? Notice he would go where the Hellenistic people were and went about looking for sinners and asking them do you want to be healed?

A loving God hastened to their defense, and using his weapon s and office through prayer and sometimes wrath to defend those hurting.

THEY THOUGHT THEY KNEW GOD

The Jews are God's chosen people. Why were they not able to discern rightly? Something stirred them up, when the paralytic man was healed, "so the Jews said to the man who had been healed, It is the shabbath and the law doesn't allow you to carry your mat." First thing, Shabbat is for giving rest to the people. Jesus cares more about you being healthy than what is in your hand on the shabbat. Here we see a clear demonstration that God has the legal right to heal and he was operating with that powers. More to the point, Jesus wants us to see the necessity of caring for the needy. Real genuine love and care! When someone needs your help do not make excuses. Do not hide behind philosophy, religious rules and your traditions.

When confronted about the rules, Jesus responded, (John 5:17-19) "My Father goes on working and so do I. And the Jews tried all the harder to kill him, for Jesus not only broke the Shabbath observance, but also made himself equal with God, calling God is own Father. Jesus assured them, "Truly, I assure you, the Son cannot do anything by himself, but only what he sees the Father do. And whatever he does, the Son also does.



Miracle 4). Feeding 5000 hungry people

(John 6:1-2) After this Jesus went to the other side of the sea of Galilee, near Tiberias, and large crowds followed him, because of the miraculous signs they saw, when he healed the sick. So he went up into the hills and sat down there with his disciples. Now the Passover, the feast of the Jews, was at hand. (v:5) Then lifting up his eyes, Jesus saw the crowds were coming to him, and said to Philip. "Where shall we buy bread so that these people may eat?"

The amount of people following Jesus was such a large crowd that he had to implement crowd control. Jesus chose to secure his disciples

first by removing them from the crowd. It please God to look out for people's security ahead of "popularity" or "acceptance" by the masses. The bible mentions specifically that Jesus commanded discipline among the crowd. He told them "sit down." Once the crowd was seated, he addressed the people's needs.

How Is God Testing You Right Now?

(John 6:6-13) He said this to test Philip, for he himself knew what he was going to do. Philip answered him, "Two hundred silver coins would not buy enough bread for each of them to have a piece." Then one of Jesus' disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said, There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?" Jesus said, Make the people sit down." There was plenty of grass there, so the people about five thousand men, sat down. Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed them to those who were seated. He did the same with the fish and gave them to those who were seated. He then did the same with the fish, and gave them as much as they wanted. And when they had eaten enough, he told his disciples, "Gather up the pieces left over, that nothing may be lost. So they gathered them up and filled twelve baskets with bread....)

Do you care if the people in your midst is unable to feed themselves? I was looking for answers many, many years ago, about an old man, a husband, and father, who became bed ridden. Unable to feed himself. I needed to learn about the meaning of his life. Why would his own family not want to care for him? How could they? What was the meaning of all that? I thought if I leave my home early morning, which was not easy, leaving my family who needed me to see about them. Sometimes it causes me having to do double trips to get something important like a child's homework that got left behind in the rush to leave after I finish caring for this father. I had hoped my action would make the family realize what they were doing is wrong. Every morning before going to my office I went to feed him as his wife and child did not care if he eats the food given him. It was painful to see.

GRATITUDE

How aware are you of the countless undernourished people living in the world? Thanks to those who feed me when I was hungry. You know who you are. You did it. And I know it was out of the love of your heart. I would also like to share that I know what it feels like to be in a Christian's home who invited me there. And the moment I arrive, am taken to the grocery store. First, I was asked what are you going to eat? Then I was taken to the grocery store and told to purchase what I will be eating while at their home. I was also given a special area to put the food. O, how God loves us! Thank God for Jesus, for many years he has been multiplying my supplies just like he did with the five loaves of bread and fish. Lord Jesus I love you with my whole heart. For many years I have been living off \$150 US dollars a month. From it I pay credit card bills. Would never complain, or beg. And sometimes give away \$40, or \$50 dollars to other family members. Sometimes make loans from savings from it. I save up the money; until it gets to a certain amount, then sends some to family in another country. I help countless persons from the little that God makes into sufficient.

Among other things I know, for sure my life is a walking, talking, breathing miracle of God's power. His goodness. Some people who came to me, I blessed from \$150, while they complain; these are people with good jobs, homes, cars, savings. Each time I blessed them, or use credit to give a gift I praise God aloud for his abundant kindness. His satisfaction He anoints me with. I own a business. God's business but will never use it for what is not intended for. Recently, I told a family member, I am no longer able to help. I did not feel sad, because I know God will provide for them as He does for all other needy ones. I am very appreciative God sends people to give me gifts. He is my shepherd and provider. I have no lack. God is a very, very good Father. Friend and confidant. I do know precisely what Jesus went around doing. I am happy, but sometimes gets to a low place, seeing

how cruel Christians are, very cruel. Oh, Satan has humans twisted.



Miracle 5). Walking on water

(John 6:16-20) When evening came, the disciples went down to the shore. After a while, they got into a boat to make it for Capernaum on the other side of the sea, for it was now dark and Jesus had not yet come to them. But the sea was getting rough because a strong wind was blowing. They had rowed about three or four miles, when they saw Jesus walking on the sea, and he was drawing near to the boat. They were frightened, but he said to them, "It is I!" "Don't be afraid."

First, thing, from in Genesis Jesus has powers over elements, time, distance, and everything. Walking on water is demonstration of His power and rulership over chaos. With him in your life do not be frighten by the coming storms. Stay calm, keep trusting God. The second fundamental compatibility is that Jesus is the word of God. Focus on Him, throughout the storms in your life. Don't worry about the raging winds. The lesson Jesus is teaching us is stay calm and trust him.

If you don't have a relationship with Jesus. When the real storm hits you. How will you weather it? Can you trust God to keep you safe in the midst of a raging storm? I can attest to having to stay calm in the storm. The level of chaos that has tried to take me down, and out, for more years than I want to count. Enough real-life wicked experiences plenty to write an entire book on chaos in the life of a modern-day believer! To the many God-fearing believers out there. It is time you stand up, lift your voice to Heaven about the chaos in the land. You know who you are. And yes, I do not think of myself as a Christian. Has not, for many,

many years, because I do not like the attitudes. Some the devil keeps angry about things which happen as a child. It seems no one can help; they like embitterment. I love God too much to stay bitter 40, 50, 70 years. Church belongs to sick people but if they are not being healed where is Jesus? I do not follow traditions. Do not belong to any religious sect. I am a believer in God of the Hebrews, try to live following Jesus' examples. We ought to have a relationship with God which is intimate. Work on living close as possible, to the written word of God to conquer evil.

How Do We Recognize Those Who Love God?

People who saw Jesus with their own eyes, witness several miracles had big problems. Disturbances everywhere, people could not understand him. The demonic world was very agitated. It is likewise a test for us today. A test of our faithfulness and continual belief in the God who saves. Many disciples withdrew and no longer followed Jesus after everything that they saw him do. Even at church no one is safe.

(John 6:67) Jesus asked the twelve disciples he chose, "Will you also go away?" People get to a place where they become overwhelmed. Even with God working great miracles among them, because there is always an anti-force working. In the following verses one moment Peter is confessing faith in Jesus on behalf of his brothers, "we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the son of the living God" (v 69). Next, Jesus is identifying someone among them with carnal faith, and having internal conflict. Why? Jesus shares that the devil worshipping with us.

Why Jesus introduced the devil In The Church

What is the purpose Satan/Lucifer going to church? (John 6:70-71) "Jesus said to them, I chose you, the Twelve, did I not? Yet one of you is a devil. Jesus spoke of Judas Iscariot, son of Simon. He, one of the Twelve, was to betray him." Wow will you look at that! He spoke of Judas Iscariot. Why give us all that information about him in those short sentences? Remember in the Bible, names identify one's purposes. At the same time while Judas is a clergyman/disciple/Luciferian. He dutifully became one in spirit with Satan. Why?

The Homicidal Attempt On Jesus

(John 7:1-3) "After this, Jesus went around Galilee; he would not go about in Judea, because the Jews wanted to kill him." Now the Jewish feast of the Tents was at hand. So the brothers of Jesus said to him, "Don't stay here; go instead to Judea and let your disciples see the works you are doing. Anyone who wants to be known doesn't work secretly. Since you are able to do these things, show yourself to the world. His brothers spoke like this because they didn't believe in him." Again, can I say, wow will you look at that! After the rave appraisals, praising Jesus and people coming from the four corners looking for him to be helped. Hearing he is highly competent how did he, we, make such a rapid decline to an underachiever? Jesus accepts those comments very well. Do you?

(John 13:2) "Super being ended, the devil having put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him." He left immediately after sitting at the table eating with Jesus to go and betray him. (John 14:22) Judas—not Judas Iscariot asked Jesus, Lord how can it be that you would show yourself clearly to us and not the world?"(John 18:1-6) When Jesus had finished speaking, he went with his disciples to the other side of the Kidron Valley. There was a garden there, Jesus entered with his disciples. Now Judas, who betrayed him knew the place, since Jesus had often met. Judas has Insider's information. Bad!

JESUS BETRAYED BY A KISS

Judas is described as a betrayer. His name linked to his purpose. That specific name also means one who praise God. That was why Jesus chose him. How does one get from being a disciple to becoming a devil? It is the answer Jesus gives; the devil entered him. John pointed out that he had a devil because Lucifer was working through him to kill Jesus for money. John also tells us; Judas was a thief (John 12:4-6). We gain very good insight as to how Satan is manipulating him. He is ruled by envy, covetous, the lust of the eyes. He did not love Jesus but rather enjoying the opportunity of being around him. A key piece of evidence is pointing out his father. Judas character is revealed by looking at his father (see John 8:44). For whom did Judas betray Jesus? Who were the people Lucifer tricked? A pastor/disciple/luceferian-the kings on earth, government, soldiers, religious leaders, and regular people (John 11: 45-47;18:1-4, 19:1-42).

The Father of Luciferians

(John 8:44) "The father you spring from is the devil, and you will carry out the evil wishes of your father, who has been a murderer from the beginning. He did not uphold the truth for, in him, there in no truth; and now, when he speaks for himself, he lies. He is a liar and the father of lies.

Satan always need an insider to help him out. To commit murder. People across the globe needs God's intervention. Do you understand that? Satan have several believing that there is no life after death. Thus, they have freed themselves from God and conscience. The Bible says that they eat the bread of wickedness and drink the wine of violence (Prov. 4). They set trap for the righteous because they say those people oppose their way of life (Isaiah 53:7). These are our own people, family, communities, nation, the world. This can easily be verified in our lives presently, in our home, church, school public offices. A crowd led by the chief priest betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver. (Acts 1:16-19) "Brothers, it was necessary that the Scriptures referring to Judas be fulfilled. The Holy Spirit had spoken through David about the one who would lead the crowd coming to arrest Jesus. He was one of our number and had been called to share our common ministry. (We know that he bought a field with the reward of his sin; yet, he threw himself headlong to his death; his body burst open and all his bowels spilled out.

The real challenge

Compromise and dishonesty are our challenges. Like on so many occasions when we are tested several of us fail miserably. Judas just kept failing and never change his behavior, told the chief priest and elders "I have sinned for I betrayed innocent blood." They replied what is that to us? That is your responsibility Judas threw the money down went and hanged himself. Where was Lucifer to stop Judas committing suicide? He left Judas on a tree so many days that his neck tore, and his body explode. What kind of a father is Lucifer he rejects him? As Judas' usefulness ended, Lucifer, the religious official, his entire network rejected <u>him.</u> Not even a burial no one mourned for him or celebrated him. (John 10:10) Jesus said, "the thief comes to steal and kill and destroy but I have

come that you may have life in all its fullness!



Miracle 6). Healing the blind man

(John 9:1-2) As Jesus walked along, he saw a man who had been blind from birth. His disciples asked him, Master, was he born blind because of sin of his, or of his parents? Jesus answered, "Neither was it for his own sin nor for his parents' sin. He was born blind so that God's power might be shown in him. (John 9:6) As Jesus said this, he made paste with spittle and clay, and rubbed it on the eyes of the blind man. Then he said, Go and wash in the Pool of Siloam. So the blind man went and washed and came back able to see.

Have you seen such evil? Imagine only experiencing darkness from the time of birth. And what are people in your life only concerns for you? Who sinned? Job puts it this way, "I know that my Redeemer lives, and that in the end he will stand on the earth. And after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh I will see God; I myself will see him with my own eyes—I and not another. How my heart yearns within me! If you say, "we pursue him: let us find a charge against him; be afraid of the sword yourselves (Job 19:25-26).

Let's go deeper, people, have emotional, physical, spiritual defects. Sick hearts, wicked mindset! These are sobering ways that we treat each other. At times we use their defects to shame them publicly. Some people are belittling one another, but rest assured we will answer for it. Every action is recorded in the book of life. One day the throne will be set and the books open. Each of us will answer God, then, we will regret that we hated knowledge and did not fear God. Moreover, many of us will be surprise, very surprise of what is written in it.

What this Doctor teaches about the others

(Sirach 38) reads, "Give due honor to the doctor for you need him and God himself established him. Healing in fact comes from the Most High, the gift of healing comes from the Sovereign. The doctor's expertise give him prestige and wins for him the admiration of the powerful. The Lord created medicinal herbs which grow on the earth, and these a sensible person will not despise. Remember that he used a simple wooden rod to purify water and so make known his power to everyone... they, too will pray to the Most High to grant them success in healing in order to save life. Bottom line is: Know God for yourself because, even your doctor's success in treating you depends on God answering your doctor's prayer."

Do You Understand The Callousness?

(John 9:8-9) His neighbors, and all the people who used to see him begging, wondered. They said, "Isn't this the beggar who used to sit here?" Some said he is the one. Others said, "No but he looks like him." But the man himself said, "I am he."

What is the lesson? There definitely is a misappropriation and distortion of the word of God and the power of God and people living holy lives. Draw from all these events human weaknesses, greed, selfishness, and wicked hearts. Learn where to put your trust. King David says, in God alone one should trust. Beware of people, when they come to complain to you. I have seen those who have taken from others who think that they are blessing their leaders. Thinking I am doing a good thing by planting seeds in religious leader's life. But the persons talk about them like trash. So, and so, don't have a pot to piss in, but is fresh. It stunned me, thinking but you just collected your goodies from the same person who you are saying do not have a pot to piss in. Why don't you stop taking their blessing! That way they may can buy the pot to piss in., People will take your last and trample upon you, as they crawl on your backs.

The Bible is not "magick"

Notice how the one who is most powerful, went about looking for an opportunity to give something good to those who do not have. You should be careful who you trust. Thinking they care about you or your situation. Many people think that they can make friendship with their aifts. Ah, think again. Usually they flock great leaders. Some people who are drawn to you are exploiters. And human's heart is sick internally and we are sick external. Jesus said, I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives his life for the sheep. Not so the hired hand, or any other to whom the sheep do not belong. They abandon the sheep as soon as they see the wolf coming; then the wolf snatches and scatters the sheep. This is because the hired hand works for pay and cares nothing for the sheep. I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me.

Do you know, your Shepherd? If you do evil you are not his. Turn away from evil.

Jesus telling the people who He is

(John 10:22-27) The time came for the feast of the Dedication. It was winter, and Jesus walked back and forth in the portico of Solomon. The Jews then gathered around him and said to him, "How long will you keep us in doubt? If you are the Messiah, tell us plainly." Jesus answered, "I have already told you, but you do not believe. The works I do in my Father's name proclaim who I am, but you don't believe because as I said, you are not my sheep. My Sheep hear my voice and I know them; they follow me and I give them eternal life. They shall never perish and no one will ever steal them from me. What my Father has given me, is greater than all things else. To snatch it out of the Father's hand, no one is able! I and the Father are one." (v.31-33), The Jews then picked up stones to throw at him; so Jesus said, I have openly done many good works among you, which the Father gave me to do. For which of these do you stone me? The Jews answered, "We are not stoning you for doing good works, but for insulting God; you are only a man, and you make yourself God.

How Does Those Actions Promote God?

Do not look at this as the Jews, because what it points to in human is bad behaviors. Is this not being presumptuous? Pause, think about the position of God. He truly loves us. He is more powerful than anyone. Is the highest position of power, importance, influence, in Heaven and all the earth! God institutes rules which no one can change. Even so, today right now, humans exist that will not make any effort to repair the damage done to God or against Him. If this is not a combination of behaviors for him to severely punish and send destruction. Then what is?

Another argument is the Jews are God's first born, a chosen people taught by God. What would make them forsake God, reject him? In (Exodus 15:9) we see a mysterious event; there the enemy describes a plan for those revering God. "I will pursue, will overtake, I will divide the spoil, My lust shall be satisfied upon them: I will draw my sword, My hand shall destroy them."

Let us use the first time a word appears in the Bible concepts, to dig deeper, for understanding "lust." The word can be found in another piece of biblical history: The Garden of Eden. When the two first people: Yield to temptation. It connects to Adam and Eve, "Eating forbidden food," and yielding to temptation, materialism, as an aspect of sin, a bad decision. When the woman first wrongdoing was recorded relating to false wisdom. A similar word for "lust" is "desire." A strong appetite for something. Example, a person can have a strong desire for his favorite ice cream. Or, a teenagers' strong desire for independence. A very good story about a teenagers' passion for independence is shared by "Jada Pinkett Smith" on her platform. Read it.

In (John 14:29) Jesus tells us the reason for giving us prophesies, "I have told you this now before it takes place, so that when it does happen you may believe." He teaches us the world is full of chaos. And there is a real <u>destroyer</u>. Also, why John wrote about these chaotic situations. People struggle for friendship. Who to follow? What to do for our children! How do we respond to a neighbor's need? What is acceptable to God? Unacceptable. How can you know people's decision are not the best until you see the results?

What Can We Do Different?

Yeshua was not using charms, spells, or ritual to produce supernatural effects. He was not charming people into changing their behaviors. The people looking for him were tired of the same old thing and looking for change. Jesus had no need to conjure up demons making anything seem to disappear, for entertainment. It does not matter how stubborn the sickness was, once he shows up that thing is permanently gone. If it is a demon, when it sees him coming it tries to find somewhere safe to escape from Jesus. Demons knew Jesus and them had nothing in common, the bible says when they saw Jesus coming toward them, they cried out, "What have you to do with us Jesus of Nazareth have you come to destroy us. I know who you are the Holy One of God. Demons fear him and humans don't something wrong with that.

How is your counselling, does it promote healthy living? We need the word of God to guide our decision-making processes. A difference exists between those who have knowledge, wisdom, understanding and uses discretion. Rav Shaul's says we should, "Remember Christ Jesus, risen from the dead, Jesus, son of David preached in my gospel. For this gospel I labor, and even wear chains like an evildoer, but the word of God is not chained (2 Tim 2:18-19). And says, "Let him who confess the name of the Lord turn away from evil.

Two observations

Looking at people's action after the blind man was healed: 1. Several had a problem with when the healing took place those, are the believers in God. They believe the scriptures. But Jesus rebuke them. Why? The rebuke came because they believe that because they read the bible, they know the truth about God. It is a dangerous thing when humans, we do, several of us, feels that we understand God's mysteries.

2. Additionally, the bible tells us plainly that "Not even to his holy ones has the Lord given full knowledge of all his marvelous works." It is a shame how foolish we are. These are things that cause breaches in our lives. Avoid behaviors

that is just time wasting. It destroys many people. Hurt the upright because we are **"know it all."**

Danger to hurt Jesus was real because of some know it all. This opens us to what follows, remember everything that God does revolve around Jesus. He honored him by forming a unique style of governing with, Jesus and the Holy Spirit, the only unifying government that exists throughout the entire universe. They operate as one. God honors Jesus because of his humility and commitment to His purpose. And to the powers of God. And he pleases God.

Do you understand good or bad behavior?


These are two very different actions. Do we understand the example that the mother of Jesus shown? She demonstrated something missing in today's believers. To see people's problem and go out of your way to fix it. Even if you have to solicit the help of people not ready to take on that type of responsibility.

(John 10:16) Jesus told us, "I have other sheep which are not of this fold. These I have to lead as well, and they shall listen to my voice. Then there will be one flock, since there is one shepherd.

Receiving the fullness of God

As I was about to look up the word "one" in the English dictionary. I heard the Holy Spirit, whispers this word to me—"whole." When action truly begins to reflect Jesus', we will preserve those in danger, save, rescue humans in ruin. A big difference exists between being healed and made whole. Faith in Jesus alone made one woman whole (Luke 17:19). In the sense of to be completely healthy. Rav Shual, encourages the believer, saying, that God Himself is connected in bringing us to perfection and complete blamelessness, in spirit, soul and body until Jesus returns. (John 10:41-42) Many people came to Jesus and said, "John worked no miracles, but he spoke about you, and everything he said was true." And many in that place became believers.

Master open our eyes, ears, please help your people hear and believe the truth.



Miracle 7). Raising Lazarus from the dead

Finally, this is the seventh and last miracle that John recorded. He opens the first line by introducing the sick man, Lazarus.

(John 11: 1-5) There was a sick man named Lazarus who was from Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha. This is the same Mary who anointed the Lord with perfume and wiped his feet with her hair. Her brother Lazarus was sick. So the sisters sent this message to Jesus. Lord, the one you love is sick. On hearing this, Jesus said. "This illness will not end in death; rather it is for God's glory, and the Son of God will be glorified through it. It is a fact that Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus; yet, after he heard of the illness of Lazarus, he stayed two days longer in the place where he was. Only then did he say to his disciples, "Let us go into Judea again, "They replied, "Master, recently the Jews wanted to stone you. Are you going there again?

(John 11:11-15) After that, Jesus said to them. Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep, but I am going to wake him up." The disciples replied, "Lord, a sick person who sleeps will recover." But Jesus had referred to Lazarus' death, while they thought that he meant the repose sleep. So Jesus said plainly, "Lazarus is dead." And for your sake I am glad I was not there, so that you may believe. But let us go to him. Then Thomas, called the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, Let us also go, that we may die with him.

From the left to the right members in our churches are plagued with nattering issues.

THEY TRAVELLED TOGETHER TO LAZARUS

(John 11:20) When Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went to meet him, while Mary remained sitting in the house.

(John 11:21-22) Martha said to Jesus. "if you had been here, my brother would not have died. But I know that whatever you ask from God, God will give it to you." Jesus said, "Your brother will rise again." Martha replied, "I know that he will rise in the resurrection, at the last day." But Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection. Whoever believes in me, though he die, shall live." "Do you believe this?"

Jesus Full Of Compassion Wept Publicly

(John 11:32-33) When Mary came to the place where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet They answered, "Lord, come and see." Jesus wept. The Jews said, "See how he loved him!" (John 11: 34-35) Then he asked, "Where have you laid him?" They answered, Lord come and see." Jesus wept. (John 11: 38-44) Jesus, again deeply moved, drew near to the tomb. It was a cave with a stone laid across the entrance. Jesus said, "Take the stone away." Martha said to him, "Lord by now he will smell, for this is the fourth day." Jesus replied. "Have I not told you that, if you believe, you will see the glory of God" so they removed the stone. Jesus raised his eyes and said, "Father, I thank you, for you have heard me. I knew that you hear me always; but my prayer was for the same of these people, that they may believe that you sent me." When Jesus had said this, he cried with a loud voice. "Lazarus, come out!" The dead man came out, his hands and feet bound with linen strips and his face wrapped in a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Untie him, and let him go."

This miracle allowed the people in the entire region to see the glory of God that He is the source of life. Yet many said that they do not want what he offers. People refuse to accept how great His deeds are. Think, Lazarus is dead. He was not in a coffin. No, he was in a grave and stunk. But once Jesus spoke the burial clothes had to go. Not to be worn by Lazarus, for now.

Who gave authority to bind Lazarus?

When Jesus said loose him that was it. He is the one who overcomes death. Conquered it at the cross and raised with resurrection power. The Messiah possesses all powers over death from creation. The one who came at Creation and bowed all the way down to the lowest part of the earth to breathe life into human. Never stops caring and loving us. At the tomb where Lazarus laid for four days stunk. Jesus the light of the World who dwelt among the darkness, but the darkness could not overpower the light. The one with authorly Order the people "Loose him, and let him go." Much more important is, the example. What does this mean for us?

Here is a simple, answer, "death" had bind Lazarus. But Jesus has power and authority over death, specifically over evil, to undo it. Here, he forbids it by His undisputable authority. In his teaching to the disciples, he told us, "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed." Are you a disciple of Jesus?

This is your exact mission! A calling, given to every Godfearing believer, (Isa. 58:5-6) Where it says, "Is not this the fast that I choose: 1. to loose the bonds of wickedness, 2. to undo the straps of the yoke 3. to let the oppressed go free, 4. and to break the yoke? 5. Is it not to share your bread with the hungry? 6. and bring the homeless poor into your house; 7. when you see the naked, to cover him and not hide yourself from your own flesh?

Then shall your light break forth like the dawn and your healing shall spring up speedily; your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard. No one can say that have not seen how formidable God's power is, yet from one generation to the next we reject Him and ignore His instructions.

Following this line of thinking, Isaiah 58, words are particularly interesting because it covers the entire ministry of Jesus. Early provisions, wonders, awesome deliverance. He starts, by first taking disciples to his home, teaching them. You also identify miracles one through seven in the Isaiah

58 explanation. So why, do people practice exploitation in workplaces globally? Refusing to cancel people's debts, whether its respect, or honor that was owing to you. Why we see others ill clad in our own families and do not care? **Why promote mass chaos?** Darkness? Confusion?

Why do we test God? Almighty God with the power to make us fall into snares. And then burden us with disgrace. He allowed wicked people to rule the ones less wicked. Until we humble our self. Why talk more about people's sin and less about wanting to see them whole? People dying without care. We bind each other with wicked evil words. Tie up lives as sorcerers.

THE WORLD WILL HATE YOU!!!

Let me tell you what he has done for me. Let me praise him. If I had nurtured the wickedness that everyone has done me, in my heart God would never listen to me. I struggle to let the hurt go, but when I ask for his help he listened. That way I can do what Jesus do. Instead, of being bitter you do what Jesus do. And the lights will turn on, our lives will turnaround at once. The righteousness that each one of us practice in our personal life will pave our way, the way for those watching us. Then God of glory, the Almighty God who lived among men, will pave the way before us perpetually, in a hostile world.

Are you prepared to stop bad behaviors? Jesus is Light of the world. Be the same way, I have chosen you to produce fruit. To be light in a dark world. Yeshua, (Jesus) encourages us to remain steadfast in the midst of a chaotic world. Share his word to an imperfect people in a way that helps us discern clearly between right and wrong. Human's heart needs the Light because evil in one's heart opposes unity. People who are resentful, hateful, holds on to past pain. Go the opposite direction if they refuse to change. Additionally, no matter how they call on Jesus, work miracles, in his name do not believe that they know Jesus (Matt.721-23). The big problem with that is Jesus embodies all that love represents. There is no bitterness, evil or hatred in him. Let him take root in your heart.

Humans are those who carry about trouble

Father says, "I come to test your qualities of good behaviors." In (Jere. 42), people ask the prophet go and seek God on our behalf (v 21) Jeremiah answers, "I have told you today, though you still do not obey Yahweh your God in all that he told you, through me.

God cures our pain caused by human troubles

August 26, 2020, YHVH said these words, "You are to look at the action's—people's activities were wicked. Since the history of humans on earth. Lack of responsibility, no compassion is to be laid on civil and religious leaders, you, me, family, friends causing the suffering of the people. Jesus points to behaviors as cause of prolong misery on the people at a low place.

"Blessed are the ones who God corrects; reject not, therefore the lessons of the Almighty." He cures the wounds he has afflicted; he strikes but he also heals (Job 5). Amen.

We are alive because of God's <u>faithful love</u> (Lam 3:22-24). Addition, Jesus already explained the chaos that will be in the land at the end of days—rumors of war, morally bankrupt world, lawlessness, unparalleled deception; all over. But bear in mind, God is still with us.

People's behaviors vary in quality, good, outstanding, high standard! Or bad. We are all tested, on the degree to which your behavior is good... Which reveals the good or bad parts of one's self. It is why Jesus choose disciples. Tells them follow me. He teaches humans how to capture the very nature of God. He focuses on training us the true characteristic typical of God, to make it easy for a believer to live them (John 13:34-**35).** Honesty is very important in a friend. Jesus begins by mentioning this character in Nathanael, because nothing is more sacred in a relationship! When Nathanael's friend called him to follow Jesus, he asks, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" Philip answered, "Come and see." Later, when Jesus saw Nathanael coming, he said, of him, "Here comes an Israelite, a true one; there is nothing false in him."

Jesus Allow The Same Rights To Others

Allow the same rights to others as we allow ourselves, because failure to do so; instantly causes personal and social issues. What does this teach you about the character of God? What is the combination of his qualities that makes him this particular kind of human? Do you have the ability to understand right from wrong? Good or bad? Do you exercise (your personal choice) of the action you choose to exhibit accordingly? The biblical history has shown that since bible times, religious, ethnic, racial conflicts are increasingly severe. What have we learned? Please say you are understanding?

God-fearing believers should demonstrate good qualities. Jesus demonstrates the highest qualities of loyalty, courage, love, and so on. "Faithful love" is one of his most attractive traits. This usually takes the form to act in a specific way, "steadfast" showing faithful love by being true to God's covenant (See Jere 2:1-13). Kindness is another of his outstanding qualities. He donated his time to make water into wine at the wedding feast. Are we prepared to change our behaviors? What will you do different?

Yeshua (Jesus) Came Solving Problems

Jesus came to the world solely for the sole purpose of solving personal, social problems, religious extremism, bullying and discrimination. Ask ourselves, why do we still have these issues? An example, of his outstanding leadership: several persons might call Nathanael's words rude; Jesus calls it honesty. He admires it, as valuable, because what Nathanael said shows others his real self. It is perfectly in character, in Jesus' views; persons should speak honestly to each other. He points out Nathanael's action as a man of exceptional character. Notice Jesus' good structures to guide us, that when people speak honestly; we respect them for doing so.

Jesus Promotes Character Building

Addition, God is the definition of loyalty and truth. An issue that affects millions of people across

the globe. Yet, everything that Jesus did while living on the earth aimed at developing good qualities in us. The bible teaches God remains, faithful, even when humans are unfaithful to him (2 Timothy 2:3), "labor like a good soldier of Christ Jesus." It says believers, should be courageous and strong. We must avoid the very appearance of wasting time. Rav Shual, the apostle wrote "Remind your people of these things, and urge them, in the presence of God, not to fight over words, which does no good, but only ruins those who listen.

Religious Intolerance

Where people learn religious intolerance? It is not from Jesus' teachings. In fact, he fervently disproved it. "Whoever welcomes one of these little children in My name welcomes Me. "John said to Him, Teacher, we saw someone else driving out demons in Your name, and we tried to stop him, because he does not accompany us." Do not stop him Jesus replied (Mark 9:37-39).

Today, religious intolerance, <u>sin</u>, are reasons people are still suffering worldwide. Stemming from a society or groups; specifically refusing to tolerate one's practices, persons, or beliefs on religious grounds. Today, because of different religious practices, many people are bullying one another to accept their point of view.

As a result, the world is plaque with violence, resulting in injury, death or psychological harm. It takes character to admit when one is wrong.



Have you read God's instructions to you?

The people opposing Jesus had the laws of Moses, oral laws, and the prophets, teaching them the very special quality or features of God. They knew several things that is typical of God and easy to recognize. To give an example, "This is what Yahweh says: I am going to open your tombs; I shall bring you out of your tombs, my people; and lead you back to the land of Israel.

You will know that I am Yahweh, O my people! When I open your graves; when I put my spirit in you and you live...You will know that I, Yahweh, have done what is said I would do" (Ezk. 37:12-14). When the Bible spoke of bringing back people from the grave, (resurrection) it was pointing to God's work. He is the one with legal authority, power to raise back to life decayed body from the grave.

Isn't it clear? Yet, some people among Him were unable to recognize, Jesus quality is a part of who God is, specifically to do good things. Also, only God, accepts humans, whether, our behavior is good or bad. He bends all the way down to where you are full of infinite, love, good, understanding, patience and making you feel like a real person; solving your problems. That is what true love is. (See 1 John 3:1) which says, "see what singular love the Father has for us; we are called children of God, and we really are."

Disciples are encouraged to imitate God as it is written, so that you may be children of your Father in Heaven. For He makes the sun rise on both wicked and the good (Matt. 5:45)

Jesus is the resurrection and the life. He said all who believes on him though they die shall live again (John 11;25) Do you believe this? Besides, when will we care by pursuing, justice for all, rich, poor, strangers, foreigners? My message to you all, is do not be afraid of the future. Surrender your life to God, believe on the Lord Jesus.

In Conclusion Practical Points

Today, "A statue in the Lateran Palace in Rome depicts Judas betraying Jesus with a kiss." Let us never forget the painful death of our Savior and the evil humans still suffers because of Lucifer.

- One of the other issues the people face, were education, lack of literacy. Head knowledge is necessity, always great, it helps us to understand practical things, but we all need the help of the Holy Spirit to understand the mystery of God.
 - (a) Genesis—Revelation God has sent human beings to deliver this main message: "Obey My voice." Do all I told you to do. People don't listen.
 - **(b)** Every time we fail to obey God's instructions, He sends others warning

us to repent and return to Him. Those people who repent are rewarded and blessed. Those who do not repent will suffer more in the end. Repenting is much more than praying a few words, it demands for us to change our behaviors to imitate the nature of God. Our sin is as our filth before God (Isaiah 64:6), this is what God says. All of us sin. Therefore, we need to be repenting and return back to God.

- 2. Development and understanding are visible and best when the knowledge of God is guiding one's destiny and eternal purpose. Yeshua (Jesus) gets rid of the people's problems and healed! Notice, for the first miracle, turning water into wine, it had a personal touch. Imagine the happiness that comes when you are married, families, friends, are all together for a happy celebration. Then the wine ran out before the party finish. Jesus was right there, touching the lives of regular people, to stop an occasion that should be joyful from becoming shameful.
- Eyewitness to a miracle that has happen does not mean people will instantly start trusting God. Even good news will not convince some people of the reality of God. Be prepared to deal with them; answer all their questions.
- 4. Each of us needs to form a personal relationship with Jesus. Not through your religious leader, but rather one that you speak to him and wait for his answers yourself. You must read the word of God put it in your mind and ask Him for wisdom and God's understanding to apply it to your life, let it guide you to help others; with menial day to day tasks. And do not be exploiting anyone.
- Make direct contact with the people in your home, community, nation. Physical relationships are very important and a necessity to learn appreciation of the

individuality of each person's gift, need, struggles, or distresses. The bible remarks explicitly that Jesus saw that the crowd was hungry. This is a specific case that is mentioned that you be aware not to try and teach hungry people. Man's basic needs is food. Even though there is more than one opinion that is fine. When Jesus feeds the people, he was fulfilling their basic needs for nutritious food.

It is reported: Today in our society, according to the reports, food security is one of the biggest treats to human health much more a treat than any disease. "Nutritious food is often more expensive and in some areas, access to healthy food is restricted or even non-existent. When food prices rise lower income communities have no choice but to choose prepackage, high sugar options" Www.gviusa.com.

According to un.org, "About 795 million people in the world were undernourished in 2014-2016." Are we prepared to change our behaviors? Do you have compassion?

- 6. Biblical structures are to help us fix the problems and issues affecting the globe. When Jesus heal the official man's son who was not in the location but in some distance land it was showing us what? You must openly care for people outside of your circles. Do you understand that? Other issues with the official that went to Jesus; was his entire household needed salvation. After the man receive help from Jesus, he was not unfaithful to God but in turn he led his entire household to accept Jesus as their personal savior.
- 7. A large sector of our society is affected with an issue as the man sick for 38 years. This is calling us to do deep reflections. Who am !? Am I prepared to change? What will I do different to assist others with personal or global issues? Why go to

church, read our bibles call upon God but refuse to do what he tells us to do? Stop, imagine someone sick for 38 years laying down in your midst overwhelmed depressed, believes, he would never get out of his situation until God arrived and show Him that man may reject you, not give you the care, you need! But know for certain, God will never leave, forsake his own. King David says, "Though my father and mother forsake me, the LORD will receive me" (Psalm 27:10).

- 8. "If the world hates you, remember that the world hated me before." And when everything looks impossible for man it is possible for God. In fact, he asks, "Is anything too hard for Me? We must think like Jesus to overrule the natural mind.
- 9. Lazarus dead! Why tell a dead man arise, stand up come to the source? By the voice of the Holy One comes rejoicing. "This is what Yahweh says: I am going to open your tombs; I shall bring you out of your tombs, my people; and lead you back to the land of Israel. You will know that I am Yahweh, O my people! When I open your graves; when I put my spirit in you and you live" (Ezek. 37:12-14). In addition, see the exodus. (Ex.15:7). In the splendor of your majesty you crush your foes; you send forth your fury, which devours them like stubble. God will wipe away death and griefs. "Happy are the people who knows how to praise their God."
- 10. Humans are predominantly wicked, very cruel and ferociously violent. John wrote of Yeshua's ministry calling us, to arise; from sin, evil, dead things that does not profit anyone. The very first people God called, chosen; original sin was division, when Solomon died. However, God promises to restore and heal and put one shepherd over us. God specifically warned His people not to learn the ways of the other nations because what they were doing

was **violent** and **cruel**. It was such <u>cruelty</u> that God destroyed them and left strict warning for us.

(Duet. 12:30-31) "Take heed to yourself that you are not ensnared to follow them, after they are destroyed from before you, and that you do not inquire after their gods, saying, "How did these nations serve their gods? I also will do likewise. You shall not worship the Lord your God in that way; for every abomination to the Lord which He hates they have done to their gods; for they burn even their sons and daughters in the fire to their gods."

The world we live in today is the way it is because of human behaviors. We chose to do everything we want to do. What's next? In response, God says, He will clean up His world, restoring every -thing raise the dead and make all things new. The choice is yours, to fight God or obey His voice. There are no other options—either we obey and live eternally or disobey and perish.

Pray to God, confess your sin. Ask him please do not punish you for sins you are unaware of. Ask for help that your thoughts be acceptable in His sight. Humble yourself. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you find the scriptures that will encourage you. Dig down into your heart and do reflection. What is in there that has no business being in there. First, we must accept our wrongdoing before God and the sins against him and ask for his pardon, we need pardoning, which is freely able through the atoning blood of Jesus but you must confess the sins. If you understand the book of John you will survive to end.

Have you suffered punishment at any time in your life? Hated by someone who does not understand your approach? Have you witnessed a group of people team up to hassle anyone innocent? Have you lost everything? Who is at fault? Why are we all suffering, love ones dying without anyone caring?

Hear the voice of King Jesus, Satan, untie us. Loose us, let us go. I remove the grave clothes! In Yeshua's name, we arise and praise God. God bless us all and crown us with His glory!
