# Human trials are both spiritual and physical!!!

Job's community was forced to adapt new values. First thing first, how do we stop further similar things happening to us now? The answer to that question lies in the amazing explanation which God expressed by explaining Satan's involvement. How is Satan to be blamed for such ruin? One-word answer, (evil). The Bible mention specifically that he sent "human partners" as robbers. They rob, murder, taunt, adding, the fire he sent and burn down the business. Job, his family and the entire region suffered. Sabean raiders took out a community of valuable human lives, businesses, homes. Wicked storms, lightning struck causing natural disasters. Why? God is teaching the real human experiences Job had-to teach, and help us understand how to respond to pending disasters.

# wo ways he was of great examples to us

1). in his patience 2). the suffering. However, when reality of the pain hit him became unbearable Job gave out an outburst but never sinned. In spite of the trials and severe suffering he maintains a fair persistent trust in God

(Job 1:1-3) Job's Status/character (when destruction hits one's life all at once—how do we arise?)

> First, Job had an altar of prayer, sacrificing daily to God. Where did he gain such wisdom, superb divine knowledge (Gen. 8:20)?

- Job was influential, counsel royalty, official, provides for the poor, and needy.
- Blameless, reverential fear of God and upright
- He shunned evil (because it was wrong to do evil)
- Had huge household, very wealthy, of all the people in the east wealthiest, greatest
- Blessed with seven sons, three daughters (all ten children were killed)
- Talk about exotic vehicles (in order to make it easier to understand, the equivalents to todays, Lamborghini, Bentley, or Roll Royce). He had it all, lost everything including human lives.

- Let us analyze the problems worldwide today based on these scriptures
- 2. Recognize your personal involvement
- In order to press restart (we will share the reasons why these things happen, how they were fixed in a series. Using the book of Job, we (address few questions and the answers are outlined)
- 4. How aware are you that Satan works through earthly powers to destroy one's life, community, nation and the world? How so? (To give an example, the book of Job say he began attacking Job using Sabeans—other human beings were sent as murders destroying lives).
- 5. Please remain hopeful there is an end to the pain!
- 6. Do you believe a demonic stronghold is connected the madness happening throughout the whole world today?
- 7. Do you have a plan to respond to raiders?

Satan has not failed to shock humanity. The story is not different, almost all the text of the book of Job discloses innumerable ways he can secretly work behind the scene through human helpers and powers to ruin everything that God permits him to do. A very good example of human moral weaknesses in the world can be seen across every region today.

Before delving in the meaning of Job's troubles take a quick look back, he had economic, political, spiritual powers and influences. Job lost it all, not because of any fault. There was no apparent explanation for the attack. One purpose we can draw on is it offers guidance for today's challenges! Truly the closest; to all major crisis happening across our world now. Let us set the stages here; by reminding ourselves of Solomon's words. The king said, "I have pondered on all this and now I understand that the just, the wise and all they do are in the hand of God (Ecclesiastes 9:1).

#### This explicit detail trial displays:

- a. that God kept authority or rulership over the earth.
- Job demonstrated in his fear of God that we are not allowed to have our own way unwisely—He took God seriously. Responded fully knowing to utterly fear because He does what He says he will do.
- c. Adding Job fear that his children may blaspheme God and sin in their heart. This alone teaches that humans owe God an explanation for what we do.

## **More Than One Views**

Even though there is more than one view, visibly major crisis develops when we behave in ways that are below God's standard. Remember God quickly gives us the explanation that the angels have invisible powers. He also gives true knowledge of the supernatural forces the battle with the power of darkness and the kingdom of Satan. Sharing how he uses humans to bring destruction to their own, friends and a region.

Job had seven sons, and three daughters. Owner of seven thousand sheep, three thousand camels, five hundred yoke of oxen, five hundred donkeys and a large number of servants. In other words, many things about Job upset and troubled the kingdom of darkness.

Job must have believed that there are powerful sources that could harm his children. Therefore, he accepts the responsibility to give up valuable sleep in order to arise every morning and help his children stay safe. He would build an altar and sacrifice lambs which serves as a sacrificial covering in order to protect the children. He continuously went to His God that whatever the dark forces where it would not condemn his children.

Apparently, from Job's routine rising early every morning it is clear he understands consequences of sin, because he was offering daily sacrifices on behalf of his children. How interesting is that? Just a thought. Think about it. What if we each had someone unceasingly repenting; just in case we sinned. Identifying a real caring father. That is, it. Job then is a sign of reconciliation between God and his children or household. How many fathers you know that rises stand against what might harm their children in our world today?

(Job 1: 6-8a) Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came along them. And the LORD said unto Satan, Whence comest thou? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro on the earth, and from walking up and down in it. And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job...?

hen Satan went into the courts of Heaven, at the gathering of God and His Sons to speak with God. The most intriguing part of his conversation is why was Satan not able to find Job on his own? We will go deeper into that later on in our discussion.

What are we to do when he finds us? King David lifts his voice to the heaven pleading to God some of the most powerful prayers, which explains and make it easier for us to understand:

**1.** That Satan is the witness against humanity.

2. Satan falsely accuses humans.

3. Satan uses people within your inner circle, robbers, then upping his antics to friends, family trying to murder anyone that is a problem to him.

## FRUITFULNESS GETS UNDER SATAN'S SKIN

The following verses are very interesting particularly, Psalm 34 it inspires each of us to trust that God is the Sovereign Judge, and fearlessly guarding the innocent. It also gives clarity that, YHVH's angels encamps and keep safe those who fear him. God is also pleased to take care of those in covenant with him.

The story of our ancestors, Job, David, Peter, Shaul (Paul) invites us to distinguish that trials, bring us to a more spiritual life, on a personal level, community, and across the globe and helping societies to be much more fruitful in the end.

Many years later after Job's losses, James an author in The New Testament describes how we humans should treat each other "Beloved, do not fight among yourselves and you will not be judged. See, the judge is already at the door. Take for yourselves the patience, the suffering the prophets, who spoke in the Lords name. "see how those who were patient are called blessed. You have heard of the patience of Job and know how the Lord dealt with him in the end. For the Lord is merciful and shows compassion.

# Let us analyze the problems today based on the scriptures:

First, focus on these questions and let them be on everyone's lips: The book of Job addresses social injustice, spiritual renewal, community resilience and much more. (1). What is the real fear the feeling you get when afraid or worried? What is Job fear for his children's behavior about? What is it? This father's heart was full of fear. Indeed, its teachings and implications addressed that God's sees man's panic or phobia, but his goal is to restore everything you have lost. He wants to help auide us back to recovery. Satan also, has a plan—his push was for Job to blaspheme God.

(2). How many of you knows it is his plan for all of us? Describing Satan's attacks on Job, details his specific tactical devices bringing anyone to a tipping point to make them not trust, blaspheme, curse God. Did Job blasphemed God? What should we do?

(3). Is our society prepared for disruption and interdependence, learning new skills through biblical education? Which brings up the question why would God allow Satan to test a righteous man in such a wicked manner? The following is for our education, God realizes each one of us needs to learn, as individuals, community, the world, to adapt values develop from the Holy Bible, how to deal with real problems affecting you.

#### **Spiritual competence**

The word blameless means you are not guilty of anything bad and the problem is not because of your own faults. Each of us should do our best to present our self to God as one He approved as blameless (Job 1:1-3; 2 Tim. 2:15). Paul encourages us to present our bodies as living sacrifices. Active and proven blameless correctly handling the word of truth. Willing to sacrifice our life for God to be glorified. This indicate the type of wisdom and competence in the service of God that he requires.

Even as Job was suffering, he was not speaking evil, would not let corrupt speech control his anger.

Job 1:4-5 (Job's patterns and principles he learns from the bible). The bible gives us this rich detailed piece of information, Job's sons take turns holding banquets, in their homes and they would invite their three sisters to dine and drink with them. After each series of banquets, Job would send for his sons and dauahters and have them purified. He would rise up early in the morning, offer an offering for each of the children thinking perhaps they have sinned and blasphemed God in their hearts. This had been the routine for Job (Job 1:4). First thing first, Having the feast is not wrong. (Gen. 21:8) Abraham celebrated a feast when his son Ishmael was

weaned. Then why would Job be that fearful, when his children are feasting that they may have blasphemed God? God is teaching us this is a fear or nervousness making Job unable to think clearly. Parent do not know what children do when out of sight. Parents have hopes and fear for the future of the children. Parent should make sure children knows bad things will happen if they do not do what is right... However, we should repent, ask God to forgive them daily. Job was explicit about the reason he repents and links blaspheme to danger and fear. Think deeper! Could blasphemy cause ruin, and destruction to explode in the earth today?

eal life experiences of blasphemy: blasphemous means to be speaking evil God instill the wisdom in Job to have a real fear for Him and yield to His authority 1.) We should not think evil in our heart. 2.) Do not admire evil 3.) Do not speak evilly 4.) do no evil. People should deliberately avoid wickedness because anything humans say or do insulting to God, only harm one's self and all humans. The story of the war in Heaven is, Satan lost his authority because of rebellion. God judged him for being wicked. He is very angry. (Isaiah 14) describes a strongman that is hitting individuals, family, community, nation, world, even if you are good. It read, "How has

the oppression ceased?" How has the strongman ended? Yhvh has broken the staff of the wicked, the scepter of the tyrant who struck down the people with blow after blow who ruled the nations in anger with unrelenting persecution (Isa. 14:3-10). O, Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cast down to the ground. You who mowed down the nations! (read verses 13-14).

Satan's fall is link to what he did, blasphemed God and he causes bad things to happen.

Hence, we should have such terror or dread of blaspheming God. Do not do it. We are all required to honor God. Notice, God judged Satan for rebellion. He cannot repent. Now he wants all of humanity to do the same and be thrown in hell. Do you understand why he wishes such vileness against every human? Get it? Turning away from sin, and pray for the children one man's repentance jabbed, hurt Satan.

Only in God can we find true security if we are obedient and repent for sins very often. Job's life shows he lost everything that suffering and pain comes before true peace is achieved. God's pattern of renewal because sin entered the world. It was same for Yeshua/(Jesus) born King of Kings, no one, not one, finds fulfillment until we surrender completely to God's plan of redemption, restoration, revival of everything, person, places and things.

When Satan attacked Yeshua twice we read that he yelled at Satan. "Get thee behind me." The first time indicating he had no tolerance for Satan's voice. The next time Yeshua yelled at Satan he said, "It is finished." He endured all the full weight of Satan's assault. No pressure from Satan would stop Yeshua being obedient to God. Likewise, no pressure from Satan would stop Job from being obedient and cooperate with God's plan for his life. They were both determined to stay faithful to God. Now the responsibility is on us to remain faithful to God and resist Satan's lying schemes.

## hy Satan attack us? Recognize your personal involvement!

(Job 1:8) The LORD said to Satan, have you considered My servant Job, that there is none like him on the earth as blameless and upright one who shuns evil.....

- The Discussion: God said to Satan have you seen my servant Job that there is none like him on the earth who shuns evil? Shun means to avoid someone and or something deliberately.
- Satan answered does Job fear God for nothing? Have you not put a hedge about him, his house and all that he has on every side?
- Much more important, God remove the hedge of protection but because Job was blameless, he did not give Satan permission to

kill him. Stop for a moment, read the bible, which says as Satan left to attack Job he went for his children and possessions first. They were partying which was normal and died. What did they do wrong? We do not know.

- We do not know what they \* did. What we do know shun lets us see Job deliberately avoids Satan because he fears, so he lives by following God's instructions wisely. Another question why first Satan kill all Job's sheep? Job would arise early and repent using them daily to offer sacrifices for sins (Lev. 4:15). Satan killed all the sheep first. Not a fair fight because that Job approaching stops God to plead for the life of his children. Actually this was before Yeshua's death, back then all humans lambs' blood. needed Interesting, this shows Job was deliberately trying to avoid the death of his children.
- \* If nothing else, the Bible says their father was concern about them sinning in their heart against God. Why, kill the servants? No clue, but Satan/Lucifer/demons seeks to do evil to us! They hate all humans— the spiritual fights are for our lives. If Satan could kill all humans, he would! What I see here, is attacks are vicious and deadly merciless; spiritual and natural. Attacking Job's possessions was to open a door so Job would blaspheme God. That way he would kill Job. It does not stop here; be on guard. Satan has a plan for each of us.
- Here is an adequate picture that any person trying to live blameless before God; Satan has a "bull's eye" target on the persons head.

- Perhaps Job hid something from Satan. How so? Anything to do with the Lamb's blood? Was the blood used to deliberately keep Satan away from his children? How interesting is that? Satan looked all over he did not find Job. Could not, find or touch Job's blessings until God points him out. Not only that but perhaps most people live blameless, that would make it harder to locate Job.
- God uses the word like to describe Job's existence there is none "like" My servant Job.
- "Like" means similar in some ways to something else. In this case, it tells us other people were similar in some ways to Job, indeed living a blameless life. How do you like that?
- Be excited, and Imagine having such an awesome privilege living among an entire group of people blameless that Satan has to go all over the earth so confused he cannot pick out the most blameless.
- It took roaming to and fro the whole earth, back in the presence of God, uninvited. Before God's own hand removed from Satan's eyes his blindfold, and pointed out Job.
- God had to test Job to defend his own honor.
- Last, it is impossible for the blood of bull to take away the sins.
- Now we have a better Covenant (Heb 10:4) bow before Yeshua/Jesus, ask him for the best protection.

# A GREAT FUTURE AHEAD

Do not be afraid of the future! Also, we all have to endure some attacks until God rescues us. (please read Job 1:13- 21) Satan sent Sabeans robbers, they stole Job's animals.

Chaldeans kill all Job's many staff. Stole his transportation.

Fire from God fell and killed his sheep—the lamb for sacrificing. How interesting is that?

Once, Satan had stolen the valuable offerings which Job would give to God. Then forthwith all the servants were killed. Next, natural disasters smote the house kill all Job's ten children. A wicked flood of evil overflowed Job's life. After all that loss (vs 20- 21), in grief Job arose, tore his robe, shaved his head. What can a person do after all that suffering unfairly? How many of us would is prepared so that someone or something more important can succeed?

#### The place is full of sad humans

Plenty people today are unhappy because we are in a situation or relationship that we do not enjoy. It makes us miserable, sad, especially if we are sick.

How many people have been depressed for a very long time, about the things in your own life? How many of us distraught that we cannot think clearly? How many are heartbroken from the loss of love-ones?

What plans do you have to help one person? Say a few lines of encouragement? God's love is here no matter how dark it gets.

# CAN GOD TRUST YOU WITH HIS HONOR?

when going through the process of Satan testing your faith in God, can you be trusted? Can God trust you with his reputation?

No persecution exists that does not involve the work of Satan to discourage humans from trusting in our God. Our history shows that all who tries to become a servant of Yeshua, and worship the only true God, as soon as we make the commitment unexpected trials arises. (1 Peter 5:6) Bow down, then, before the power of God, so that he will raise you up at the appointed time.

Enjoy the breaks you had and not be rebellious, revile and become complainers. Job lost it all, and he thought the only thing befitting was, fall down on the ground and worshipped God saying Naked I came from my mother's womb naked shall I return. God gave and he takes away. Blessed be his name. What would you do?

When good influential persons experience such devastation. It affects an entire region. Have you plan for the future? How will you be able to rise and meet sudden challenges or (enemies)? Job's wife was left. She was not killed. Did she bear his burden?

## ook at the pattern of everything that happened to push her to the tipping point.

She did snap and said to her beloved, this goes beyond what God intended for any person to bear. There is no question, Job will not change his mind about his trust in God. In fact, He even remains committed. A good example for us. Job did a careful analysis of all that he had lost and the results. And determine that everything belong to God. He is not deceived. God has the legal rights to take it back if he wishes to do so! His final analysis is everything depends on God. No one is immune from failure or lack of success. He is not accepting failures but coming to term with reality, Job said it in his own words. (Job 1:22) "In spite of this calamity, Job did not sin by blaspheming God "

Friends, there is a very powerful satanic warfare being fought, which always manifest in the physical. Look around you yourself are attack, individuals, our children, possessions, health economy, political, spiritual, education.

Addition something wants to stop our influences. This is only one pattern of the full-on assault on all mankind happening now. Remember God wonderfully describes Job as blameless. Even so, a battle was determined in the spiritual realm for his, and his children's future and destinies.

Friends Satan's attacks are real and very effective. This is true throughout the history of human life. Indeed, Satan is man's worse nightmare from (Genesis through Revelation). Maybe you are blameless, even so, you do not have immunity from his attacks. He wants to kill us all. (see prayer on our website how to counterattack Satan). No one can demand God stops the course of history for our sake. Find a way to cooperate with him.

#### Evaluation

- Notice, when Satan push humans to have to live in inhumane situations. He is trying to push you to the tipping point to raise a question and ask yourself what kind of God is this that claims He loves you. He wants you to questions God's honesty and love for you.
  - Many people prefer to worship Satan rather than God. On the other hand, after all that Satan had done to Job. We should all wonder why? Next chapter shows us what a person passed the tipping point Job's do. wife recommended he curse God and die.

Of course, several people happen to be <u>angry</u> at God. In other words, try to understand why, it is only because they are crushed too much pain. Over all, Satan has said in his heart, "I will ascend to heaven, I will raise my throne higher than the stars of God; I will sit on the Mount of Assembly, in the far recesses of the North. I will climb up above the clouds; I will be like the Most High God (Isa. 14:13-14).

We need to explain another of Satan's mission statement found in (Exod. 15:9) the ancient enemy of Israel boasted, "I will pursue, I will overtake, my lust shall...I will satisfy my anger on them. I will draw my sword and my hand will bring them down.

- Friends, where do we go to escape anything with such deadly hatred? All of us, are under attack from Satan. He uses other humans to do the job of robbery and murder...
- From observation, even if your life is embittered, it is best to obey the word of God, believe the world is his and He rule it however he wants to.
- Definitely He loves you, but you need to obey Him. (I am speaking from a place of great pain, personal experiences).

A key challenge facing us today, sad, but true, people do not know how to trust God during times of really tuff and harsh trials. When we others turn on us. Scriptures shows many turns to **"sorcerers"** even kings do but will be severely punished!

#### Why Satan hurt Eve and Adam

- Many years later, one of the big advantages to us is the same word of God is available for free, to be able to read and go to him for understanding of the real issues facing you, in a real way in the real world. The first human Eve thought she needed him. Several people, thinks we need Satan; this is far from the truth.
- Power struggle came on the stage in the Garden of Eden, where the world is introduced to a serpent (sorcery), sin and death.

Today Satan wants to control all of humanity! Trying to make us powerless against sinning. The evil in his pride persecute us. As we go on destroying our own lives.


