INTRODUCTION

Is the world ready for a real discussion about humans harming each other? The lying messengers spreading lying messaging worldwide? Truth about why we are murdering humans? Our hateful thoughts and hatefulness in the human hearts?

There is a puzzling passage in the Bible that needs digging into—It speaks about a messenger of thorn in man's flesh (2 Cor. 7). More later. For now, let us focus on Yeshua/Jesus, John and us. Thanks be to God for our deliverance through Yeshua (Jesus) the Messiah our Lord. The topic of deliverance, love, and a true servant's heart is expanded through Yeshua who provides us with the applications.

The way deliverance, love and service to others is manifested in you; will not be the same as Yeshua/Jesus, John, your mother, friend or neighbor. What we find in the scriptures is the story of a man named John called to be a messenger. To take the responsibility to represent Yeshua. John's unique role gave him a great deal of satisfaction as a messenger and he looked for opportunities to bring people from different culture and background to experience God's goodness and his love.

What we find in the Bible is a defining perspective from John, he describes all of seven 7 ideas for actions. These are common every day task that you and I can do depending on your gifts, talents and affluence or riches. You can do any of the 7 to decrease the human miseries, suffering, pain running rampant around the world. You have seven specific actions which you can take—best practices for each day that should be customized for you, according to your own ability.

For anyone who do not know how to focus on what they already do best. The Holy Spirit will help build you up with courage, strength, in your skills, knowledge and experiences. That you and your community can have an excellent approach and better quality of life. Even while learning what the scriptures tells us to do. One highpoint from John's message is it teaches us that although the Bible offer benefits. Those lessons offer little help, if we are isolated from those who we consider, to not be one of us. Not in our group. Not a Christian. Satanic or demonic! Why? How will we reach them?

Here is a question to ask yourself. Am I going far enough to do good in the world? If you want to improve the world—take action:

1. Share your gifts
2. Share your talents
3. Share your resources and possessions

Share the word of God with your children, friends, co-workers, to help people around you develop in Godly living. The key to helping others is not to point out their failures—but rather help them understand that their flesh wants what it desires. Most humans spend their whole life trying to do good and can't. Keep calm, read on!

INSPIRING THE WORLD WITH YOUR WORDS

Your distinct inspirations are enclosed—written out to you in the Bible.

There is no question whose breath is in you. To set the stage Genesis begins by telling us, God breathed “**the breath of life**” into Adam (**Genesis 2:7**). **God’s breath has inspired the whole world.** “All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished onto all good works.” (**2Tim 3: 16-17**).

HOW DO WE DILIGENTLY FOLLOW?

Is there one thing you want to do for yourself but have not? Do you clearly know who you are? All humans should focus on the sets of examples Yeshua demonstrated in the book of John. Extend yourself to improve the lives of people in the world. First, try to be forgiving and specifically work on loving those who have corrupted themselves.

(John 20:22) declares that the Messiah applies same principles of Hashem when he breathes on the disciples and said, “Receive the Holy Spirit.” **As disciples of Yeshua we are learners, His followers, God’s messengers to promote the power of God’s Word to deliver a lost world.**

The word of God goes from His mouth and it shall not return void. Each of His Word helps us associate objects with their functions.

They are solid proofs. (**Isa 55:11**) God says “it shall accomplish that which I please and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it”

We humans must play our roles well (**Job 32: 8**) “But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty give them understanding.

This includes everyone! Do you understand your responsibilities?

LIVE, HAVE FUN AND LOVE OTHERS

Bottom line is, the Spirit of God is life. That is the Holy Spirit! We need him to help us confront good as well as evil. To live, lead, enjoy your life and love others. Holy Spirit gives us strength, power, boldness, and send us out to be witnesses (**see Acts 1:8**).

You Can Be Anything You Want To

Most Christians spend their lives trying to do good and be a good witness. Trying to be like Jesus and can’t. Every day going to church or reading the bible. Attending some types of conferences. Some of us pray with prayer partners each day. Often several times in one day. Yet still, we do evil.

Take a moment, how much do you enjoy what you are doing? And do you hurt others while trying to do good? No matter how hard you work at being a good human, evil simply is in us. Our actions are evil.

So, think about it, **why does the belief you can be anything, and do anything not help us** to do more good things in the world?



Wisdom is the gateway to good and evil.

- ✓ Are your messages magnifying God?
- ✓ Is the message on your devices good? Or evil?
- ✓ Think, for yourself by God’s breath he inspires us.
- ✓ Can your words be comforting? Take a moment and ask yourself, what is the reason sending the messages you attach to your own face good? Evil?
- ✓ Be careful. God had warned Adam of knowledge of good and evil. Saying the day, you eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil you will surely die.
- ✓ **The Bible tells us corruption, lies, and fraud, lead to tougher rules.** As ten Spies brought back an evil report and breathe doubt on the people of Israel. By means of their mischiefs the spies lost their lives.

Do not be misguided, not your government, any religious leaders, family, nor you, can do anything good without much effort.

We read the Bible, get higher education, interview successful people, study polls and try harder; but still we cannot do the right thing all the time...every day.

World leaders have fail at their attempts. Local leaders fall as well. When we fail usually the plan is the failures need more attention.

Instead of investing our time In the Word of God, and in the areas where Jesus focused, particularly on victoriously solving problems.

God's promises are your guide. From Genesis He promised Adam life or death. Good or evil. What a tragedy this is Adam chose evil! It was a simple command only one thing Adam had to do. To choose the one he wants. He chose evil!

Ask yourself, what was so hard about that? And did the ancient people always succeed? No! Very often they failed just as Adam.

Surrendering your self-will to obey God is a sacrifice. This aspect of how to surrender is stressed in **(Philip 2: 6-8)** where it says, "He humbled himself, by becoming obedient to the point of death—even death on a stake." This is speaking of Yeshua.

Yeshua obeyed God, this way mankind has an opportunity to see an image and allow all of us to think about the processes of voluntarily surrendering one's life for the benefit of others.

(Duet 30:15) see I God have set before thee this day life and death, good and evil." You choose!

Are **the promises only to one man? No! It clarifies that humans are given imperative commands by the Word of God and taught; how to live close to Him in a right relationship:**

1. **Obey His commandments**
2. **Worship Him in love**
3. **Care for your neighbor**



Each of us agree the stakes for the human life is high. But we do not agree on exactly how we stay alive healthy, prosper and caring our self and others...

John says start here—God is known by the Words He gave us. He made provision to come in the flesh as Yeshua and demonstrate real-life examples to provide a basic, yet, very powerful illustration of what can happen when people focus on helping each other, those near and the ones far away to achieve common day to day activities.

No man gains true wisdom away from God. God Left His Word and keeps His promises to SAVE us. The purpose of the Word of God is to actively draw man nearer to Him in holiness and dedication to God.

The wisdom we need can be obtained by studying the Word of God. The word of God is able to judge the **THOUGHTS** of man's heart.

However, in spite of where we are and man's lack of knowledge of His Word and the failures. God is continuing to inspire us!

What Type Of Messenger Are You



From the beginning God has been using "**His Word**" and images that represent the truth to reveal His plan. His Word gives man wisdom, knowledge, understanding to build up your personal life and our world.

Noah's life literally illustrates and teaches the world a shocking lesson: For one hundred-twenty-years he educates a people who rejected the word of God. but He listens, and follow the instructions.

God saved Noah and his family from a worldwide flood! As millions perish because they choose to ignore it. The depth and symbolisms of God's plan to save a lost people goes even deeper, very, deep.

Example, He uses Moses to save an entire nation. It was easy to send Moses to deliver to them His word.

He knew of God's yearning! Moses had personal experiences of loving people who are unkind, and inconsiderate, very unresponsive, and unworthy. Even so, Moses loved them. God wants to restore humans to have a right relationship with Him.

REFLECTIVE QUESTIONS FOR YOU

1. Are you spending your time talking about "the Word of God" before it is too late?
2. Do you share only truth? Are you sending information that imparts wisdom for people to **know Yeshua is the light? Their Deliverer? Where is your focus? You are the face of the messages you send.**



As the past world slip back into chaos God sent **JOHN** with a clear message: **FOCUS! FOCUS! FOCUS!**

1. Messiah is the **Word** of God; He is God's face in the flesh.
2. He reflects God's thoughts.
3. He goes where problems, exist and fix them. Giving deprive humans, wholeness as God did in (Genesis).
4. Now, you either accept the Word and follow Yeshua's example or reject it and suffer more and also perish.

What Are Your Words Testifying To?

John uses the Word of God very thoughtfully, stressing that Messiah is the Word of God. And He reveals the thoughts and different emotions of God as you would reflect on your own face. Also, in your speech.

In context he stresses that the Word spoken or written is eternal. From the Beginning it is responsible for bringing the world into being and serves as a bridge between chaos and fruitfulness. **When describing Yeshua John teaches the world that the Word of God is Yeshua.**

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God and the Word was God."

RECOVERY IS THROUGH MESSIAH



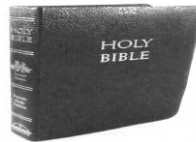
Let us ask ourselves, why would John start his ministry with such a powerful mission statement? Think!

(Matt 10:2) John was called to be an apostle. **God tells us John 1:6-9** There was a man sent from God whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe....the true light that gives light to everyone.

Do you recognize that when we speak or send a text message from our devices about a particular matter, you are now the face of that message? Any persons hearing or reading your text and then turning toward or from a particular path or direction—you ought to know you are somewhat responsible.

So, let us ask these questions:

- a) **Is my message to control other people?**
- b) **Is it fake?**
- c) **Am I promoting a lie?**
- d) **What is the objective?**



Remember this is all a picture of what witnesses ought to do. A good way to start is verifying the truth. John's first image was the "Word of God" connecting it to a human face. And brings to one's mind common day to day things he saw Yeshua doing that were good.

Many things demonstrated a consuming passion for the wellbeing of others. The foundation of this type of love is God's nature. **On the face of it, John draws beautiful pictures of God's love for humans.**

As a disciple one way he helps people was to demonstrate how to be a true witness. He was concern with people's distribution of mix messaging. Think about that.

John presented Yeshua, as the 'Word.' He is our salvation, welfare and victory. This clarifies that the "Word" of God means precisely "wholeness of who God is.

Amplifying his message to the world of who God is, John emphasized that the Word, is Yeshua and is God with us in the flesh. To Keep learners focused on Yeshua, he uses other images to give us opportunities to see God's anger, justice, favor, and love for humans. This is the privilege he had, to be intimately connected to the one who goes to battle for you, and controls or influence customs, and traditions and directing your life.

John wrote **John 1:10-11** "He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him."

Today understanding the Word of God is a MYSTERY and bigger challenge. Many people still do not understand the process by which humans are rescued from sin. They do not know that it is Yeshua came and restored the relationship and fellowship between God and man.

This is demonstrated by John. If you pay attention and gain a better understanding—of the Bible the "NIV" actually translates Yeshua as victory (**Ps. 22:2; 69:30**).

We need to rely on the Holy Spirit for clarity to understand that area of our lives. And as you can see, without the help of God, we cannot understand anything.

WHY DOES THIS MATTER?

Through Yeshua you are called and your greatest goal should be to present biblical guidance truthfully. And use your gifts to provide clarity so your audiences can find the help they so badly need for Godly living, and to find balance between good and evil WHICH ARE PRESENT IN US.

John presented a dualism of several topics to learners through the chapter. About, good and evil, life and death, light and darkness, love and hate. But his main lessons focused on the work of Messiah. That it is in him the afflicted among us find refuge. And pointed to the need for humans to believe Messiah and do good! Truth be told, the reality is, if you are struggling with hate, it will be unlikely to love others in a warm and sincere way.

Instead of focusing on trying so hard to love others. When it is clear you, yourself never received love. You do not know what it is. Start here to start loving yourself. First, pray, for the Holy Spirit to stir up the gift of love in your heart to be loving you.

John's messages were helpful, to many! But rejected by some. As people are still doing today. Even so, he places emphasis on the word **"I Am" it is an exact statement to classify Messiah as God and Yeshua (Exod. 3:14, John 6:35; 11:25; 15:1-5).**



John saw Yeshua face to face. Had access to God! Enjoy the favors that you the reader can receive as well. God wants to give you favor. This disciple and follower of the Messiah, says God is full of love.

A very different love from human experiences. It is the main aspect of God's character (**1 John 4:8**). John had the privilege of receiving this type of love from Yeshua.

Addition, Yeshua in his office, is the revealer of the glory of God (**John 1:14-18**).

Love was oozing out of John; he points to powerful images of the quality of Yeshua's character. Love does not delight in evil, but rejoices with the truth. This messenger, uses real-life examples to provide a basic yet powerful illustration of what can happen when people focus on helping others in your own space achieve common daily activities.

John draws our attention to Jesus attending a feast to celebrate a wedding. A problem developed the host had no more wine. Jesus was told of the problems and steps up and fixed it. That is what love is.

If you have a vineyard don't wait for a wedding invitation. Go! Show up at a venue with your gifts. Share some of your best wine. To make other peoples' lives very happy.

In one of the messages John refers to himself resting his head on Messiah's breast. To show that man need to focus on Yeshua and be given the opportunity to have the best conversations with him. You don't need to be envious.

This man understands "Words" that they serve as a bridge to create new life, give blessings, reach the world and stop or cause chaos. He deeply understands messaging! He **inspired us to Keep conversations focus on the Word of God.**

Stick to the Word of God, focus on it and beware to serve others and your services will always brighten your own life and the life of others.

Every Word Makes A Difference

(Deut. 6:4-9) Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD alone. You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. Take to heart these instructions with which I charge you this day. Impress them upon your children. Recite them when you stay at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you get up. Bind them as a sign on your hand and let them serve as a symbol on your forehead; inscribe them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. (Tanakh)

MESSAGING IS IMPORTANT

Reflect on Genesis, the image of a serpent talking to Eve conveys a specific message. It is **the dangers to me, you, and the whole world if we help promote an evil message.**

Please, guard the gate of your mouth. The Word of God gives life.

Put away the evil you are doing with your hands. Evil brings death. No one died until mankind was ask a simple question. Let us agree that Satan is also an agent of God and he is doing a pretty good job at testing you to choose and do good or evil. What will be your choice?

Stop focusing on evil, and trying to avoid it find something you are good at and do it more regularly.

God handed—over to man a very good world. Truth is, no evil exists! Until a simple interrogative sentence was made. The method is pointing out a dangerous trend that causes human to spread sin, lie, and death. **The first humans refused to do good to each other. You may think there are better things to do with your time than helping an unworthy person. Let us all agree that you cannot help everyone, but God wants you to do a lot of more good things to spread joy, where you live, starting with your husband, wife, family and in the community.**

Talk with yourself! What message are you spreading?

Satan plays three major roles in the life of mankind (starting in the book of Genesis 3 through Rev 22).

1. **Satan is the Tempter of man's evil inclination.**
2. **Once he has successfully tempted us. Our evil minds stand as an accuser to point out each other's sin. Which leads into contention and harassments.**
3. **Then comes death, killing of trust, resulting in cutting off a relationship and every so often an actual murder.**

Think about it are you promoting a lie? Or Death? Here is something else ask yourself, am I understanding why it was important for Satan tricking mankind to strongly doubt and be disinterested in the Word of God? We are all needed to spread a lying messaging. **Ten million things vying for our attention. So, Stop it!**

It is clear people in the Bible knew very well what is right to do and not to do.

What happened? They preferred lies. Do you believe God need help to make a better plan for the earth? What can we learn from their errors?

Ask yourself what can I learn from them about myself and issues in mine own life? No matter how much pressure is put on you. Can you do good? Do you balance between doing good or evil?

Especially in the book o Job; the author makes it very clear that all humans at one point of life depicts the qualities of Satan. Where we act as a Tempter so others do evil.



Have you travelled worldwide as yet to do evil? Think about Eve. No problems existed, not until Eve focus on a dangerous message, and she began to tell her own lies.

Think! What should you do?



What Have We Missed Learning?

Keep your eyes and heart focus on the Word of God. Like other imperative sentences in the Bible Deuteronomy 6, begins with what you are to do. Hear, O Israel, YHWH our God, YHWH is One! The word of God is to cultivate peace and help you avoid chaos. "These words, which I myself command you today, are to be upon your heart. You are to: **Repeat them-**

- ✓ **To your children**
- ✓ **In sitting in your house**
- ✓ **Walking on the way**
- ✓ **Lying down and rising up**

Think twice: Next time you take up your cellphone to repeat, or is PROMOTING unverified messaging.

Any message from your devices to weaken the human mind. Stop it!

Your appetite is to be for God's Word in your soul; repeat them with others to reach the soul of the lost, and sick people and compromising ones. Believe it. Indorse God's Word.

Ask yourself, am I approving and recommending a thing to be true yet I have no proof? Is my action showing am a disciple of Yeshua?

God said this, "Although I gave them all that they needed they committed sin (Jeremiah 5:7)

SHOULD YOU ENCOURAGE EVIL?



These are few common factors we share with Adam and Eve; first, speech and our behaviors. **Why do I say that?** The Bible is our reference and our behaviors are the proof?

WHEN WE THINK OF A THOROUGH AND WELL THOUGHT OUT PROCESS HOW TO BE A SCHEMER RUTHLESSLY TO GET SOMETHING, WE WANT IS AN ASPECT OF ADAM AND EVE EVIL BEHAVIORS.

It is not difficult to see how their actions cause damages worldwide. Ours are having the same impact.



Since Genesis humans find it difficult to identify their own strength. Thus, let us ask ourselves how did the crafted interrogated question by the Serpent harmed them? This is to be understood in the sense of one's unwillingness to listen, and follow the instructions. Eve was to help Adam.

Obey God. Why was she not willing to help? The better question is why are you not willing to help people around you that are needing help?

The truth is in spite of dangers, humans will be enablers of evil: If the evil helps to fulfil one's personal desires. In general, most humans intentionally do whatever one's emotion desires, even if it is telling a lie, theft or acting immoral, we do it, because of feeling that we can.

GENESIS IS NOT SO MUCH ABOUT THE SERPENT; RATHER THE DISCUSSION IS TO BE WHAT DID HUMANS DO? AND WHY?

THE CALCULATINGLY AND MALICIOUS ACTIONS ARE BECAUSE OF COVETING ANOTHER PERSON'S LIFE.

Each of us have our own gifts and talents. You should find out what is your strengths and improve on it by actively serving those who are in your inner circle and the ones faraway. Our speech and actions are responsible for the evil in the world, then and it is true today.

Eve's failure is connected to A BIG LIE. A lie made them took and ate something. It hurt themselves and the whole world is in trouble with people suffering and dying.

Basically, the bible says, Adam and Eve lost everything.

People do not process possible damages to the world. Until it's too late. The behavior is exactly as they did back then. No one think how to tackle the cause of the problems. Both Adam and Eve turned and made a lot of legal arguments. That is, all of it. Today we're waiting for God to fix the problem. We can't.

As you have seen, man's life is a battlefield. Isn't that so for you? Our greatest enemy is a big lie? It usually pins us down and constantly firing a barrage of its artillery at us.



One of the most wicked thing Satan has humans doing is: **lying.**

It is past time we mature, grow in wisdom! Do not be tricked to use your word or mouth generate chaos and destroying humans in the world.

Thus now, we must change our approaches. Ask yourself, if a person drinks too much alcohol kills someone and himself. **We look for WHO is responsible. Shouldn't the debate be HOW to get rid of the threats to fix the problems?**

We know who drink too much. We know who made the alcohol. What we need is to identify the solutions and do what is necessary to remove the threat.

YOUR MESSAGES BEARS WITNESS



Is your message encouraging? Truthful? Can I verify the message?

There is great effort on the part of people who refuse to think and the kingdom of darkness, for God's children to be doing everything with exception of what we are called to do. So before you press sent on your devices, pause! Stop, ask, what am I bearing witness to by sending this email to others? We need to repent!

(Genesis 31), Apparently Jacob had lived with his uncle Laban. Who were robbing him! Jacob left and it look like Laban run him down. When Laban catches up with Jacob. They agree on settlement (Gen 31:44).

(Gen 31:45) And Jacob took stones and set it up for a pillar.

(Gen 31:48) And Laban said, "This heap is a witness between me and thee this day." **WHAT IS LABAN DOING?** He places down evidence to verify their conversation. It means if the behavior should change and it can, here is proof of our vow.

Stop! do not promote ANY evil. If you don't see evidences with your own two eyes to verify the messages do not text it or be emailing it.

You Are To Point To God's Glory

John 1:6-9 There was a man sent from God whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. He himself is the light...the true light that gives light to everyone.

John describes Yeshua as light. And he tells us the light is for each of us. To deliver us from the traps of sin. This light released or deliver the world from always concentrating on doing evil. You cannot know Jesus and continually focus on doing evil.

UNCOMPLICATED RELATIONSHIP



John did not want to reduce the imagery of Yeshua with every day products. Unlike other disciples who gave us genealogy. **His focus is on God. You are standing before God.**



God is face to face with man again! John says God came to us as Yeshua., These are his qualities! I am connecting them to a human face. That you see the nature of God returned to fallen man. God did it because he is longing to restore humans to him correctly.

How does this apply to us? All His focus is on Yeshua. You see, from Genesis and elsewhere throughout the Bible God would restore and redeemed His children to Him. In the New Testament John identify that God came back to us as Yeshua,

WHAT TYPE OF WITNESS ARE YOU?

The Old Testament starts out and declares, Light. A light that causes Heaven and Earth to produce only good things. As a witness you are connected to where the truth of "a matter" is to be established. Your messages are to be based on truth, trust and conviction. God says, be a witness on the basis of multiply witnesses who sees proof with one's own two eyes. Is your text message harmful? Emails? Speech?

You are light. Think of that next time you send or forward a hashtag #MSG! Is it a lie to harm others?

What about your conversations? Here is a good example of being witnesses. (Ruth 4:7-10) It used to be the custom in Israel that for a contract of redemption or exchange to be binding, one party had to take off his sandal and give it to the other. This act legalized the transaction." Do you understand?

Walk Boldly In The Right Direction

Boaz took "**ten**" men to see the transaction and proof it happens. The two people in the contract one of them, Boaz provided all the small details in the matter. And asks, "Do you witness this today (**Ruth 4:10**)?"

What is it you are a witness to?

Let this pierce your heart. It is quite a bit to being a witness. And why are we warring against each other's destiny? Tear others down.

John was not competing for Yeshua's title or those duties...

The Bible tell us God sent John, to bear **WITNESS** concerning the light. **John 1:8-10** He came as a witness to testify about the light, so that through him everyone might believe...the world was made through him, He came to His own, but His own did not welcome Him. But whoever did welcome Him, those trusting in His name, to these He gave the right to become children of God. They were born not of a bloodline, nor of human desire nor of man's will but of God.

(Listen to me carefully let us go back to God, we are His children. God has given you a desire to accept His love or reject Him)

For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Yeshua the messiah (2 Cor 4:6). Let us therefore come boldly (ie, without pretense) before the Throne of Grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in our time of need (Heb 4:16) (Hebrew for Christians).

There is a striking resemblance to (John 1:23-24) and our life today.

Are you standing firm as John?

What value are you to others? You and I have **A LIFELONG DUTY TO SPEAK THE WORD OF GOD TO THE NEIGHBORS.** And help with their problems. Do not willfully hurt the people in our lives.

This is God's plan.

(John 1:4) In him was life, and the life was the light of men. God's **Word** is precious it gives divine intelligence and comes as Wisdom to help you do the right thing. But some people spurned the Word of God and rejects it (Isa 5:24).

Would You Like God To Praise You?

Perhaps the grandest witness is John, the bible as a lot to say about the topic. **Exodus 20:16** You shalt not bear false witness

Deut. 4:26 Heaven and earth bears witness to our physical actions. **Job 16:19** "surely now my witness is in heaven; He who testify for me is on high. Notice God says mankind's witness is in heaven.

As a disciple of Yeshua John inspires us to focus on the Word of God and teach it to others.

No matter what else happen to John. Yeshua himself, gives the highest praise to this man. Addition he demonstrated how to be among Yeshua's inner circle (**Mark 5:37**).

Think about it because of the Word of God; John was among an exclusive group of people close to Yeshua and at the center of power of the world's system regarding the elitist and secret societies.

We also know John's birth was a miracle. It is true, from Genesis to the book of Malachi the Bible had been prophesying the coming of the Messiah and his death. What can we learn? Right now, John wants everyone to be aware that Yeshua came He is here, so consecrate yourself unto Him, and be holy. And follow His examples.

WHAT THIS TELLS US

You are called to help the lost focus on the Word of God. Called by God, John witness to us that the Messiah is the Son of God and holy. He kept the focus on Yeshua and identifies his divinity and declares the humanity of him (**John 1:1-13**).

John knew his own identity and he did not compete with Yeshua. Yeshua's life was prophesied ("See, I will send the prophet Elijah to you before that great and dreadful day of the LORD comes) **Mal 4:5**.

At the transfiguration of the Messiah. The Bible says Matt 17: 1. "And after six days Jesus taketh

Peter, James and John his brother, and bringeth them up unto an high mountain apart, Vv 2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as light. Vv 3 And

behold, there appeared unto them Moses, Elias talking with him.

Vv 9 As they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them saying, Tell the vision to no man until the Son of man be risen again from the dead. Vv 10 And his disciples asked him saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come?

Vv 11 And Jesus answered and said unto them Elias truly shall come first, and restore all things. Vv 12 But I say unto you, That **Elias** is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them. **Vv 13 Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John the Baptist.**

Admit that knowing Yeshua did not provide John with an easy life. He was **imprisoned** by religious rulers and the elitist (**Matt 4:12**).

Beheaded (Mark 6:26-28). What does Revelation say happen to him because of his loyalty to Yeshua?

What is the main message to the world from John? Stay focused. And we should identify when someone with superior expertise is in your midst, and take the time to give them room to share their wisdom. John was not leaving anyone on the outside looking in. He draws those

that shows interest in the inner circle, so they feel the love of God through Yeshua. To understand the set apart life that he lived; one of obedience to God. In order for the power of God to be active, alive and be demonstrated in Yeshua.

You were created by God. He manages an invisible kingdom. **You work under that invisible system ruled by Satan. His messaging is lies, alternate truth.** To distract us from the things of God. And tests you to choose between good and evil.

What does the Word do for you?

1. The Word of God is your keys to success (**Gen 1**).
2. It confuses the tongues of the wicked (**Gen 11:3-9**).
3. It destroys the dwelling of the wicked (**Gen 19:24**).
4. Heals demoniac (**Mk 1:23-26**). Raise the dead (**Luke 7:11-16**). Heal the impotent (**John 5:1-9**)

Most people understand God create humans into a free broad space, fill our lives with His word; to guide us on our journeys. But they do not try to understand the Creator of the world is relying on you—to do your part in making the world a better place, in a real and personal way for **all future generations.** **How do you fulfil your tasks:** be obedient

QUESTION: IS THE STATEMENT JOHN MADE "NO MAN HATH SEEN GOD" TRUE?

It is correct! No place in the Bible is it written or spoken of that God was seen in the flesh. Not by Adam or anyone else for that matter.

(John 1:18) says, No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him."

John wants us to write down—the Word of God, believe it, confess it. That Yeshua explains who God is. And this chapter is the record of John explaining Yehua's Divinity and human character, when men came from Jerusalem to ask him, "who art thou?"

and use your gifts to make the world a better place (See Duet, 6 and Matt 19)! **Responsibility:** When God created man Elohim, left us to make decisions. Sets life and death before you to choose the one you prefer. Which means you must choose His will over your personal desires. God says "obey my voice." It is in your power, to be loyal to my Word. You choose! Think, if water and fire is before you to reach out your hand: Choose the one you desire. Choose God and live in love. At the same time though we recognize the usefulness of many systems in place to govern the world. Do you ignore the fact no perfect human structure exists? Regrettably, not one human has provided real justice or peace, it is a cruel world that we live in.

What Brilliance In This Answers?

Confess not neither deny it

John 1:21-23 Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou a prophet? And he answered, No. Then said they unto him, Who art thou? That we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself? He said, I am a voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as the prophet Esaias. John's answer was about Jesus. So much love shown in spite of the elitist interrogation.

What is your daily message about? Do you deal truly with the people in your midst? What is John's uniqueness? John has shown us the heart of a true disciple. **One who opens his mouth for the good of the world.**

When the Word of God is in you, you shine light not darkness. Until we begin to lead and control one's own appetites, desire and passion according to the Word of God. We cannot see true love or experience real peace in the world.

MINISTERS OF THE WORD

Here is something John is teaching us. You must declare the Word of God because he told you to do it. A declaration is something you know and that you tell to others.

While we may be influence by others to do evil! God holds each of us individually responsible for our WORDS and actions. Because we believe what we are told and acted on it. **WHAT IS HAPPENING TO US?**

John's life can encourage you and me. How to change awful issues and stop, no good; arguments we encounter from escalating into senseless fights.

Would you answer? (John 1:25) "Why baptizes thou then, if thou be not that Christ, nor Elias, neither that prophet."

John did not fail to admit the truth. He stays calm and focused on the topic "I am a voice of one crying in the desert, Make straight the way of the Lord. Wouldn't it be nicer if humans are to grasp deeper meanings of the things of God how to overcome man's evil plan and change any situations for good rather than grilling the people doing God's will which we do not understand?"

Calmly John stays in the inner circle of Yeshua, to describe what he sees with his own eyes as an eyewitness.

(Jn 1:29) the next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him and and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world". **What should we be doing?**

We want to keep the focus on Yeshua for the right reasons. And love God and do what He says!



Do it because He is our Creator! Those who do what God says is a wise man and is also blessed with much understanding.

(John 1:15) tells us that "John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, "This was he of whom I spake, he that cometh after me is preferred before me; for he was before me." **Get it?** John is praising God. In the eyes of humans Jesus came after John but by him being the Word he was before Creation.

Notice where the emphasis is! On God and the focus on Yeshua the expert for restoration of life. **Is John saying new things?** No! They were from the beginning. No one trying to distract him had success. He testifies of what God has done and what he has seen.

This is how to stay focus and speak about that which was from the beginning "the Word," which we have heard, and seen with our eyes, looked upon, and our hands have handled.



John was not interested in comparing his status with Jesus. His focus is, this is God! And He has made us is very own children! That is the type of friendship you want and the witness you want to be. Not sending lies you cannot verify and has not handle with your own two hands.

Guard your mouth be not rash with your mouth. Let your words be view just like John has shown. Suffer not your mouth to cause you to sin.

Addition, God deserves our full attention, when talking to the world about him. Guard your heart. Do not be too quick to repeat unconfirmed reports.

Your life is a gift from God for a specific purpose. You only need to know your strength and shine in that area. Do not be jealous about another person's gift. You don't really want to live in their shadow. Do you?

Are you going to remember that?

In (John 1:32) John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove and it abode upon him.

Beloved what did John bear witness to? Isn't it what he sees?

- He is telling others what he sees with his own two eyes. He reports truth.
- Truth that he can verify evidence he looked at.
- He handled the proof with his own two hands.

He stops short of saying this is God in the flesh came back to man. Precisely meaning look at the written Word of God, in the flesh. Here is what he looks like! Looking at the Word of God is as if you are looking in God's face.



John sees Yeshua with his own eyes, walk and talk with him. We must see something for one's self ahead of pointing to it as accurate. He uses truth to lead others to God. Sometimes we must ask our self where is the proof? This way we will not be promoting the enemies' lies.

Are you thinking what is your role in the world? You are a disciple of Yeshua (Jesus). **As a disciple of Yeshua you play a prominent role in the life of everyone in the world.**

Your words are important. Do you understand we hurt people who trust us when we lie to them?

And when we repeat things that we know are not true?

God's call is to be holy. You must realize something disciples and the sinners have the same problems in the world today.

What are we to do? Listen to what Yeshua said, "Love you enemies, do good to those who hate you. Bless those who curse you and pray for those who treat you badly. Difficulties in your life is for a specific purpose they bring to the forefront God's glory. Our passion must be for what the Lord wants you to do for his glory.

Do You Grasp The Word Of God?

In the Old Testament David says "My enemies will retreat when I call on You; this I know that God is for me. In God, whose word I praise in God I trust; I am not afraid what can man do to me. I must pay my vows to You, O God. John is also praising God.

Part of the actual sermon (Jn1:14) says "the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John tells us the Word of God took on bodily existence in order to enlighten all mankind. Every day from arising; see yourselves standing in front of God. Your first thought is recorded by Him.

Our thought is like words! Think about each word before you utter any from your mouth.

(Jn 1:23) men were sent to grill John and they ask, "**What do you say about yourself?**" John simply gives an answer by repeating the Word of God written in an earlier chapter. "**I am the one in the wilderness, make straight the way of the Lord**" (seen in Isa 40:3).

It is an astounding statement especially because he keeps the focus centered on the Power of God demonstrated by Yeshua who shares the nature of God to heal the world. And to take away each man's sin.

Another of the disciples, Luke provides us facts—he said "John proclaimed a baptism, for

repentant people to obtain forgiveness of sins and he went through the whole country bordering the Jordan river (see **Lk 3:3-6; Jn 1:19**). There, Luke has shown us what he seen with his own eyes.

Here, as in Luke 3, Luke does not refer to personal friendships or anything except facts.

We make mistakes. Misjudge and every one of us is confused. And we are all encountering unbearable problems every day, and all day long in our lives. And there is difficulty telling the truth.

Let us be clear there are no perfect situation. No one perfect living. Yet, how can we act with others in a way that would make Jesus be happy to give us praise?



John uses other images of real-life, such as, water and wine detailing a rational wedding in which the host was experiencing chaos. And few other symbolisms teaching us; to receive Yeshua and live pleasing to God by doing good things. These are not according to the fallen nature of man; but we should all display the nature of God. Full of EloHim let everything in your discussions remind us of the sovereignty of God over all worldly things.

Severe illnesses are Jesus' specialty! As healing THIS man born blind to improve his life.

How magnificent is Yeshua's works! His eyes are on those with their courage shaken.

A concern father came for his son's well-being it drove him pleading with Yeshua to come and heal the boy. An invalid sat in the midst of people in severe misery as other strong humans stand by, doing nothing to help him get well. But Jesus did.

God was among humans. The one who has the ability to be walking on water is with us. This is how great God is and the distance God will go in order to make human's life much better than we are expecting him to do. One thing very special about John is that he is delighted in the things of God. Genuine delight.

God Came And Gave Us Peace

"Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world." His wonderful blood has cleanses us of all our sins.

- **Sins of hearing**
- **Sins of speaking**
- **Sins of our hands**
- **Sins of the foot**

As it is said in Leviticus 14:14.

Do you get it? John wants us to see how blessed we are. That the one who created joy and peace is walking among us. And Yeshua is calling you to be his disciple. Focus on him.

(John 1:35) Again the next day after John stood, with two of his disciples; and looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith behold the Lamb of God.

And two disciples heard him speak and they followed Jesus.

John is a confident man; he knows his strength and weakness. This is what knowing your skill level is he is teaching his disciples that Yeshua is the one of greater skills. Look, this is one with the expertise that you need to be successful in your own gifts and in life.

It is important for you to see who God wants you to follow the examples of. John allowed them to go and be counseled and trained by Yeshua.

They were men in those days looking for a better future.

You Can Improve the World

Most necessary for a man's life is Yeshua. If you want to improve the world draw people into a relationship with Yeshua.

John is playing the role of helping others gain what is in their best interest. If you are representing a person, take the time to learn about their gifts and talents. See where they need help and point them in the right direction. And talk to them about the things that are important to them and God.

(John 1:38-39) Then Jesus turned and saw them following and saith unto them, what seek ye? They said to him Rabbi, which is to say being interpreted Master,) where dwellest thou? He said unto them come and see. They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day.

You are going to rile people up

Ask yourself how should I act toward your Creator? Do you act in a way that is improper? John was captivated by the Word of God He pointed people to the Lord Yeshua. Saying He is the light of the world. The way and the truth and the Life. Go to him He is God come back to humans in the flesh. Was everyone happy? No!

What was John saying to the people for the officials in his community to become riled up about if?

The Bible explains John was warning the whole world to repent. Luke provided some facts about somethings which John said, it was just as written in the prophet Isaiah: Listen to this voice crying in the desert, 'Prepare the way of the Lord... "Everything crooked will be made straight and the rough paths smooth; and every human being see the salvation of God."

John said to the crowds who came to be baptized by him, "You brood of vipers! How will you escape when divine punishment comes **(Lk 3:4-7)?**

Addition he was baptizing many. Report went back to some rulers and those are the ones who sent other men, to find out who is this causing such a distraction from the norms. John's mind was on people being saved from God's divine judgement.

People did not know before whom they were standing or who is permitting them to have real-life conversations with him.

God was with us as a man, named Yeshua. Not only John, but also, Yeshua gets some people riled up. The One who can rid man of all our burden the only One who is good is with us.

Today you have an actual opportunity to have union with God because Yeshua redeemed mankind. Yeshua always direct people to the Father. You can come into his tent and learn from him how to be saved. Learn how you can receive eternal life. And learn to help anyone who is needing to learn how to function in an invisible system which Yeshua clearly states, is very evil in its operations.

Think about the exaltedness of God. You are able to stand in the Divine Presence of the Almighty and Most Powerful God. Although we have acted in ways underserving of His love in the book of Matthew Yeshua helps us understand much better how to have eternal life.

First, Yeshua wants you to understand that your salvation is a gift to you from God. He encourages us to keep the commandment of God. **"Do not kill; do not commit adultery; do not steal; do not bear false witness; honor your father and mother, And love your neighbor as yourself."** (Matt 19: 18-19).

Looking at human complexity notice the biggest question those who were riled up ask John it is— Who are you? John being filled with the Holy Spirit from he was inside his mother's womb was humble. He knows that only Yeshua's blood can take away the sins of the world. Boldly he tells the world Yeshua (is made manifested in Israel).

Everyone should know He is greater than I am. Follow him to get clarity and learn that humans are servants of God. Don't worry about worldly things concentrate on Yeshua your life is in darkness. You need to receive Yeshua to be delivered and live in the light. John bare record, saying I saw the Holy Spirit descending upon Yeshua. This is the one whom God has chosen to bear your sin.

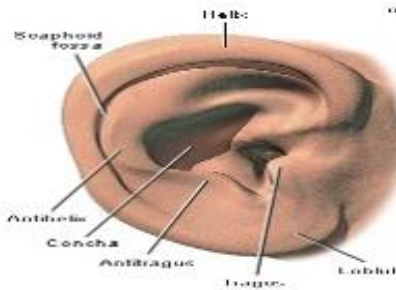
John equipped humans to have the mindset of God. That God wants you to set aside time to build your relationship with him. Come! Spend a day with him learning the lessons boggling your mind and making you sad.

1. Man has two nature, evil and a good one. You are an important person, to God and sin have no place in your life.
2. Learn to be humble! Even if you are in the right but someone is harassing you. If you can remain calm under the pressure you will have a better chance of convicting those resisting the Word of God.
3. When people come to rage war against your mind. They are only trying to make you less than God has gifted you to be. So, don't fight them. Point them to Jesus.

YOU ARE THE FACE OF THE MESSAGES SENT FROM YOUR DEVICES

Disciples should follow the examples of Yeshua (Jesus)

GOD IS THE CREATOR OF MAN



Listen with concentration to the Word of God. Several texts teach us that God has entered the world and into the human heart to draw each of us to individually be hearing His Word.

Actually **(John 1:40)** Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, was one of the two who heard what John said, and followed Jesus." (KJV).

See, what happened? Andrew heard what John had to say about Jesus and he accepted it and made up his own mind to follow Jesus. Nothing stopped him.

On the other hand, pay close attention to the first thing Andrew did as he found Jesus. **(Jn 1:41)** He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messiah, which is being interpreted, the Christ." This is saying when God is in a person there are some specific things that the individual will do. For example, God begins to express Himself in that person so the individual starts testifying of knowing God. That should always be the main focus.

Among the disciples who had followed the Messiah the Lord was their main focus.

John Focused On Jesus As Man

Repetition! Repetitions! (see **Gen 3:1-5**). What is the objective? It was for mankind to call out to God. **(Jn1:34)**, "Yes, I have seen! And I declare that this is the Chosen One of God!"

Do you notice how John kept hammering his points into the human ears? He wants us to know we are actually talking to God. This is **God's divine revelation showing us how to communicate and bear with each other about a matter — until it becomes clear, strong or believable.**

WHY FOCUS ON JESUS AS MAN?

John delivers clarity for listeners to understand that Jesus is a man; but look at his actions. Isn't the detail exactly like the things which God did for the earth at Creation?

What are you looking for?

John was unique and specific in the delivery of his witnessing. For example, the Bible describes for us God consistently created miracles for seven days. John will spend his time focusing on seven miracles of Jesus. In Genesis you will see the heavens open to achieve God's work respecting the necessary stages of the earth development.

Jesus came to show us how to make better use of the resources of land. Everything was gathered together and in the beginning were created in great numbers into a fertile earth. Within a few centuries all of what was created the land to raise cattle, man to establish towns were destroyed because of man's evil approaches to living their life.

JOHN'S GENERATION

(John 1:43) the next day, Jesus decided to set off for Galilee. He found Phillip and said to him, "Follow me." **(John 1:45)** Phillip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the law and the prophets: he is Jesus, son of Joseph, from Nazareth." 46 Nathanael replied, "can anything good come from Nazareth?" Phillip said to him "Come and see." **(John 1: 47)** When Jesus saw Nathanael coming, he said to him, "Here comes an Israelite, a true one; there is nothing false in him.

Do you know what Jesus is saying to each of us? This is it; nothing false is to be in us. Even if it is hard, you must speak the truth.

These are the Words of Jesus he recognizes those that are His as the ones who speaks the truth. Not just saying what you feel people wants to hear; but rather you are to tell the truth at any cost.

When Nathanael was called to come and see the evidence of Yeshua for himself. Yeshua praised Nathanael for not having any deceit in him. How could this be?

That is a big deal. The man has not yet become a disciple and he has no deceit in him!

This is a genuinely honest man. **What does this tell us?** It shows that we have control over our own heart, with the exception of; if we have an illness or is possessed...

Those people who are not ill and is deceitful (a demon) or sin nature ruling their evil heart.

WHO ARE WE?

(John 1:48) Nathanael asked him, "How do you know me?" And Jesus said to him, "Before Phillip called you, you were under the fig tree and I saw you."

We are responsible for telling the truth. But why say before he was called. Is our mission different? Non-believer or believer? NO. We have a mission to talk about the Word of God wherever we go. We are to declare God's wishes and represent God. Think for yourself and ask why are human beings' speech and actions connected with such evils?

There is nothing in the chapter to connect John with jealousy. He knew that the call on His life was to represent God. This is a mental image, teaching humans to make grand declarations about our God. John wanted no misunderstanding in those he was teaching. His desire is for the world to follow Jesus. Forget the distractions ignore them.

God is our refuge and only help.

Are you having difficulty to share and bring other people in our inner circles and give them room to grow? All difficulties in life is because of **our sin nature**.

Jesus knows who we are. We need the Word of God to guide us how to be messengers of God. The Bible constantly refers to our ears. Hear this and to listen. Obey. You were given power to rule your own body.

It is your duty to decide, take action about what you want to be an envoy about. What do you want to be communicating? Who you want to represent! Good? Or evil? You decide what gets into your own brain.

John uses the word **FLESH** to describe Yeshua (Jesus). Do you know why? The emphasis is on the humility that is in a man of flesh and blood as we are. Why can he humble himself to represent God?

Think about it the one who Created everything is with us.

Imagine this hearing someone disapproving of you and saying can anything good come from your place of birth? Most people would shun such persons.

Depending on your own status you may even be more insulting and have the person smacked and punished badly. Some people have responded do you know who I am? I am _____ fill the blanks.

In John 1:14 the writer told us that God became human, and was obedient, while being mocked and scorned to the point of death,

To underscore the level of humility of God. John describes him as a **LAMB**. Imagine that! Despite being the owner of the whole world, he became a creature, mere man, a real person to live with us. And to show us how to do good to one another. **Are you understanding?**

God had to come back to us. To show how to overpower evil while the world is trying to murder you.

It is better for Jesus to recognize us and praise us than we praise ourselves.

TRUE WISDOM

(Jere 11) "Who is wise to understand these events? And who is the one Yahweh has chosen to reveal them: why has the land perished and been laid waste like desert where no one passes? "Let not the wise boast of his wisdom, nor the valiant of his valor nor the wealthy of his wealth. But if someone wants to boast, let him boast in this: of understanding and knowing me. I am Yahweh, the merciful; I implement justice and rule the world with righteousness. For in these things I delight"



THE PURPOSE OF OUR HANDS

(God made the woman taken from the man's rib and brought her to the man). **(Gen 2:25) Yahweh God took man and placed him in Garden of Eden to "fill it and take care of it." The physical hand of God is another power to create. What are you doing with your hand?**

What are you doing with your mouth? Nothing matters, if we are not obeying the voice of our God, Elohim. In Genesis 32: 3 we find an emotional setting! Where Jacob prepares to meet his own brother Esau. But was downcast, because of a past feud. Jacob thought Esau might be coming to meet him with hostility...Taking precaution Jacob

sent out messengers to meet Esau. **(Genesis 32:3)** reads "And Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother unto the land of Seir, the country of Edom, And he commanded them saying Thus shall he speak unto my lord Esau."

Here you have a good example that a messenger is to be an envoy of a leader or king to communicate

the leader's wishes and represent that person. Do you understand it?

Yeshua teaches us that He came to represent God. That we learn these things and do them so you be filled with His joy. As you and I walk out our life pursuing our dreams. **(Prov 13:17)** says, "An evil messenger stumbles into trouble but a faithful envoy brings healing."

As we continue compromising, it will be only to our own detriment. Let us look at another set of messengers when God choose Gideon to lead Israel into battle. Where did they set up camp? What does the Bible say God sees Gideon as? God tells his some very strange information about the people who had come to fight him. Why?

Who did God tell Gideon to send back to their home? How are these people like the generation today? Where did God tell Gideon to go that his faith be strengthened?

Judges 7: 33 " Then all the Midianites and the Amalakites and the children of the east were gathered together, and went over and pitched in the valley of Jezreel. But the Spirit of the LORD came upon Gideon, and he blew a trumpet; and Abi-ezer was gathered after him. 35. And he sent messengers throughout all Manasseh; who also gathered after him: and he sent messengers unto Asher, and unto Zebulun, and unto Nephtali; and they came up to meet them. 36 And Gideon said unto God, If thou will save Israel by mine hand as thou said, Behold I will put a fleece of wool only, and it be dry upon all the earth beside, then shall I know that thou will save Israel by mine hand, as thou hast said...40 And God did so that night: for it was dry upon the fleece only, and there was dew on all the ground.

Chapter 8, Then Jerubbaal, who is Gideon, and all the people that were with him, rose up early and pitched beside the well of Harod: so that the host of the Medianites were on the north side of their hands...

The point is that when we follow a leader, one must be sure, the individual is actually a representative of the Most High God. The person should be consulting and praying to God, promoting God's plan. Going in the right direction according to the Word of God and proclaim God's will and represent God. Irrespective of the leader, scriptures must be fulfilled not according to human will but be done aligning to God's timetable.

- Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and the greatest commandment
- And the second is like it: "Love you neighbor as yourself
- Do not murder
- Do not commit adultery
- Do not steal
- Do not bear false witness against your neighbor
- Honor your father and your mother

Love your neighbor as yourself.

IN CONCLUSION

The example here is, if you are listening with concentration you follow up with action.

(James 4:7) says, "therefore submit yourselves to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you. Below are Isaiah's warning and word of hope to the earth

(Isaiah 33) Woe to you, O ravager who never have been ravaged, you O treacherous one who have not been betrayed! When your ravaging is over, you yourself will be ravaged; when your treacherous deal are ended, you yourself will be betrayed. O Yahweh, have mercy on us who put all our hope in you. Be our strength every morning, our salvation when trouble comes.

People flee when you thunder and threaten, nations scatter when you rise majestically. Your spoil, O nations will be gathered like grasshoppers or locusts leaping and pouncing at grain in the fields. Great is Yahweh who dwells in the heights who fills Zion with justice and right at any time he makes you secure. Wisdom and knowledge are the helpful riches, the fear of Yahweh will be your treasure.

(Isaiah 33:7) The people of Ariel Lament in the street, their envoys of peace bitterly weep. The highways lie waste with no traveler in sight. For the covenants were broken, the promises trampled down; no one has been respected. The earth mourns and languishes.... Yahweh says now I will rise up, now I will be exalted now I will lift myself up. This is the great God whom we should fear. Respect Him! It is God, that we should be representing! The Word of God, should be in your texting, emailing and talking about it.

What does it mean to listen to someone? Specifically, to listen to God

Isaiah was peering at the future. Although the future will be great! What he was seeing and dealing with; is life as you and I are seeing it today. Oppression and discontent! Tribal wars, people being proud of their belongings. The Assyrian army had his city surrounded and was ready to move in and assassinate them; kill male, female, and babies. With all the valiant warriors of Judah the enemy was surrounding them. Cutting off all the travels. Today, there will be no peace in the world until Jesus returns.

The destruction is in every nation. But God plan is to rise up and save those who are listening to and obeying Him. To listen means to pay attention, heeding and performing the given tasks. As in scripture where it describes that Adam listen to his wife and ate the fruit from the tree **(Gen 3:17)**. **So, who** listens? Who do what God say? Do we hate God?

PAY SPECIAL ATTENTION TO THIS SECTION

The questions to be answered by every HUMAN BEING is: **What are we fighting for? It is not time to promote human lies. The people that are blessed today is because:**

Abraham obeyed the voice of God. (Gen 22:18) reads, "Through your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed, because you were willing to obey me."

Abraham did not blindly obey God. He did not remove his ears from listening to the voice of God. He heeded what he understands to be God's requirement of him. **John asks those that were breaking God's covenant how will you escape divine punishment?** Where will you be? It is the sin that is in us striving with us to give the flesh what it wants. The sin inside of us is delivering us to do what is evil. In fact, scriptures put it like this, "the mindset of the flesh is hostile to God because it does not submit itself to God's law, for it is unable to do so...because the mind is contradicting God's plan."

THE COVENANT

The entire book is based on "obey my voice" from Genesis to Revelation, God proclaimed by His prophets—when His people obey His voice, they are populous and prosperous and the land inhabited. **Blessed humans**—We are all blessed. Created by the Almighty Elohim, in His image to be like Him. (Jere 7:23) teaches us, 'But this thing commanded I them, saying, "obey my voice" and I will be your God and ye shall be my people. Walk in obedience to all I command you that it may go well with you.'

WHY IS EVERYMAN FOR HIMSELF? WHAT WILL YOU CHANGE? WILL YOU?

This is a very cryptic message to the whole world.

(2 Cor 12:7) Lest I become proud, after so many and extraordinary revelations; I was given a thorn in my flesh, a true messenger of Satan, to slap me in the face."

Why is a messenger of Satan in man's flesh? What could this mean?

Let us look at "the principle of first mentioning" in the bible. Why do that? It is because wherever something is first mentioned in the bible it sheds light of subsequent concepts and meanings for that specific word. **(Gen 3:17-18)** is the first mention of "thorns." Those who did not focused on the instructions of God but rather were trying to achieve an abundance for themselves actually murdered and cursed the whole world.

WHO IS THE MESSENGER OF SATAN? WHAT IS THE THORN IN MAN'S FLESH?

In stark similarity, (Genesis 3:17-18) reads, "To the man, He said, Because you have listened to your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I forbade you to eat, cursed be the soil because of you! In suffering you will provide food for yourself from it, all the days of your life. **It will produce "thorn"—The scripture is clear** our lives will be an ongoing descent. It's also clear that thorns are connected to Satan and as well as sin. Also noted the curse in Genesis is attached to pain **all the days of mankind's life**. Have you given much thoughts to why someone or something is in a man's way to stop him or her ascending all the way to the top? **Ask yourself am I a thorn in the flesh of others?**

WHO IS THE THORN? WHAT IS THE THORN IN YOUR FLESH?

Are we the thorn in each other's flesh? It is us that are used to spread a bad name about a person who is climbing up. Dragging them back to a painful descent. Get it?

In the book of Judges, a righteous man warns Israel about Abimelech by speaking these words in a parable.

(Judges 9:7b-12) Listen to me you leaders of Sh'khem then God will listen to you. Once the trees went out to choose a king to rule them. They said to the olive tree, 'Rule over us!' But the olive tree replied, "Am I supposed to leave my oil, which is used to honor both God and humanity, just to go and hold sway the other trees?' **CJB**

(Judges 9:13) And the vine saith to them, Have I ceased from my new wine, which is rejoicing the gods and men, that I have gone to stagger over the trees? And all the trees say unto the bramble, come thou, reign over us. And the bramble saith unto the tree, if in truth ye are anointing me for king over you, come, take refuge in my shadow; and if not—fire cometh out from the bramble, and devoureth the cedars of Lebanon.

Every Man For Himself—Sadly, this is how humans are living throughout the world today. Proud. Rejoicing the gods (demons). We want to rule others. Just like the trees that have their abundance and do not care about the others. That is us. It is all of the human race. It is all about "MY" things. God is calling each of us to true repentance for making things into our gods and things and people are ruling over us wicked evil men.

What are we fighting for? To recap thorns represents:

- **Rejection and replacement of God's plan for the world**
- **Sin**

-Curses

-Humans' unworthiness of God's grace and mercy and love

Yeshua took the thorns that should be ours. Man placed it upon his head as they mocked God with us. Imagine someone putting a crown of thorns into your skull. How much of that pain could you endure? This is a very cryptic message to the whole world.

God took away your sins. An innocent man Yeshua's blood is flowing for you. For your forgiveness for all the sins you have done. In spite of all our wickedness.

Who is the thorn in your flesh? Pain you experienced. Harassment from others. No matter how unworthy you may be feeling right now of your mother's love. Father's love. Even of your children's loving you. If there is a human being you know and the person is acting like a thorn in your flesh. Pricking you. Trying to ruin your life—bare it because God will give you the strength to endure until your weary soul finds rest from this evil world. **You will be inflicted by evil words and people's actions because of sin.**

Most people find it very difficult to find their strength and take action to help make the world a better place. Since we were taught to focus on our weaknesses. Focus on other people's failures. Keep repeating anything that is negative. Make your friends, relatives or neighbors mistake not go away.

John equipped us with the mindset of God by giving us some vivid description of things we can do in our neighborhood and the world to make people happier and more successful. When Nathanael referred to Yeshua and ask, can anything good come from the birthplace of Yeshua? Yeshua answers him saying although I know your thoughts even if you don't speak them, I am grateful for your honesty. No deceit is in you. He identifies Nathaniel's strength rather than pointing out his weakness. When you do what Yeshua did by identifying a person's strength it is easier to build team spirit and a safe zone for that person to share their thoughts, gifts and life with you. That we can all move in the right direction going forward. Do you understand that? (Rom 8:5-6) Those walking according to the flesh tend toward what is flesh; those led by the spirit, to what is spirit. Flesh tends towards death, while spirit aims at life and peace." Only Yeshua can give us true peace, accept Yeshua, then the Spirit of God will help you to do the things which you think are impossible. Example, teach you to love, **God. Love yourself and genuinely love others the ways God intended. Can we remember that? Finally, what type of a messenger would you like to be? Are you agreeing to evil wishes to harm other humans?**
